Niaouli is a large evergreen tree native to Australia. The trees have five-inch long leaves and yellow-tinted flowers that flourish in tight spikes at the ends of the branches. The flaky look of the tree gave it various nicknames, such as paperbark or paper bark tea tree, and bottlebrush. A relative of Tea Tree, Niaouli has a sweeter aroma. Its refreshing, woody aroma is due to its eucalyptol content and composition of monoterpenes. Widely used in a variety of cosmetics such as lotions, creams, soaps, and toothpastes, Niaouli helps keep the skin and mouth healthy-looking and clean, according to preclinical research. It may also help to relax specific areas when used in a massage.

- + Add one drop to an adult facial cleanser or toothpaste.
- + Add to a favorite cleaning spray.
- + Include as part of a soothing massage.
