Marking scheme

- 0 The candidate does not attempt to do the task.
- 1 The writing does not display an ability to communicate although meaning comes through. There is gross inadequacy of vocabulary, spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- 2 The writing displays a limited ability to communicate. There's little evidence of sentence structure and message is difficult to follow. The examiner finds control of vocabulary, spelling, punctuation or grammar inadequate.
- 3 The writing displays an ability to communicate. The writing is organised well for the message to be followed most of the time. The examiner is aware of vocabulary, spelling, punctuation and grammar which intrude frequently.
- 4 The writing displays an ability to communicate. The writing is organised well for the message to be followed throughout. The examiner is aware of errors of vocabulary, spelling, punctuation and grammar but these occur occasionally.
- 5 The writing displays an ability to communicate without causing the examiner any difficulties. The writing displays a good organisational structure, which enables the message to be followed without such effort. The examiner sees no significant errors of vocabulary, spelling punctuation or grammar.
