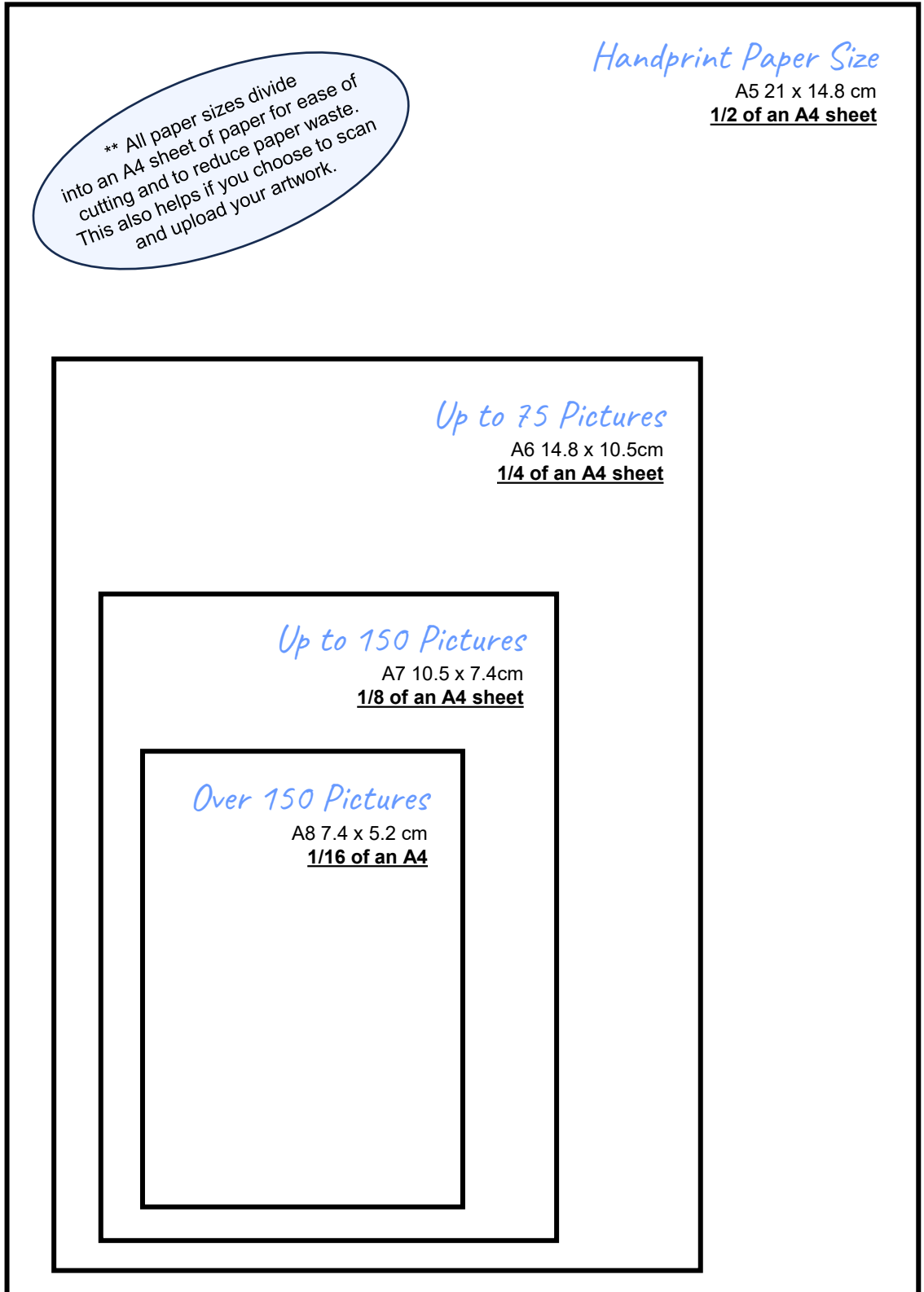


Drawing Paper Guide

IMPORTANT: Drawing cards and marker pens are supplied with your kit
OR
Use this guide to cut your own white paper and to get started asap.



Drawing Pen Guide

Group Screen Printed Designs

Option 1

Use BLACK MARKER PENS ONLY.

DO NOT USE pencil, ballpoint, thin artline or coloured pens.

The following pens are preferred for drawing artwork, this will ensure consistent line width, clear pictures and legible names.

1. Sharpie Finepoint
2. Artline 0.6
3. Pentel Sign Pen
4. Child's Black Texta

NOTE: Using the right pens and markers is SO IMPORTANT to ensure lines are thick enough for printing after the drawings are reduced in size for the group layout.



Group Full Colour Digital Prints

Option 2

FULL COLOUR drawings can use all the colours of the rainbow.

Let the kids make use of every coloured texta in their pencil case.

Artwork can also be done with paint or crayons, however textas or markers pens will give the best result.

You can also stick down interesting colours and patterns using collage.

We recommend nice strong colour and lots of it.

Please DO NOT USE glitter or metallic pens as the shimmer won't reproduce.

Also, highlighters and faint pencils are not recommended, as the artwork can be lost when the image is scanned and digitised for print.
