- The concept of love at first sight



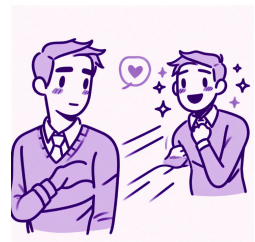
3. What is 'Polyamory'?

- Unhealthy relationship



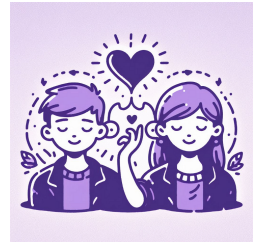
5. What is 'Unrequited Love'?

- Catfishing



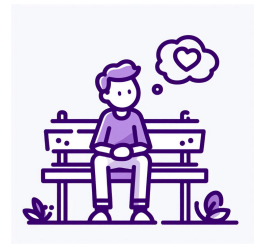
10. What is 'Orbiting'?
