Videoconferencing allows the City to continue to conduct essential business and comply with Public Health Administration recommendations to protect the public and City employees and limit exposure. Please be advised that some Traffic & Transportation Commission Members may attend this meeting via videoconference. The public has the following options to provide comments during the meeting:

OPTION 1: IN-PERSON

The public may attend this meeting in-person. Those wishing to speak are asked to complete a speaker identification form located at the council chamber entrance and place it in the box near the speaker's lectern. Comments are limited to no more than three minutes each.

OPTION 2: VIA EMAIL

Members of the public may submit their comments in writing by sending them to the Public Works Engineering Division at nalqam@buenapark.com or nwray@buenapark.com. **Please submit all comments and questions by 5:00pm on the day of the meeting.** All comments and questions will be read during the meeting.

OPTION 3: VIRTUALLY (VIA ZOOM)

You may request to speak by dialing *9 from your phone when the designated public comment period, as listed on the agenda, has been opened. After City staff confirms the last three digits of the caller's phone number or Zoom ID and unmutes you, *the caller must press *6*. Callers are encouraged, but not required, to identify themselves by name. Each caller has three (3) minutes to speak.
