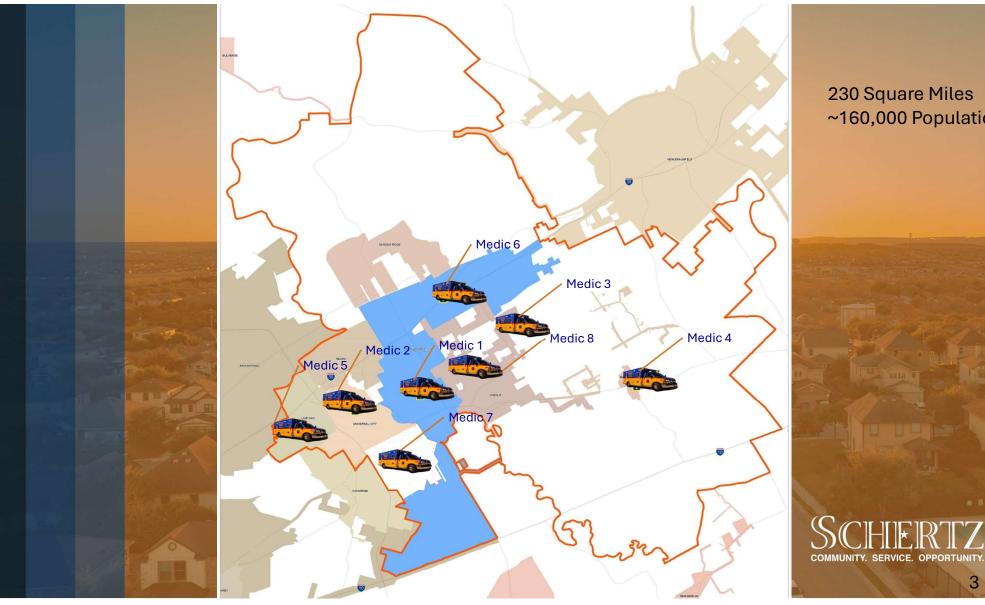

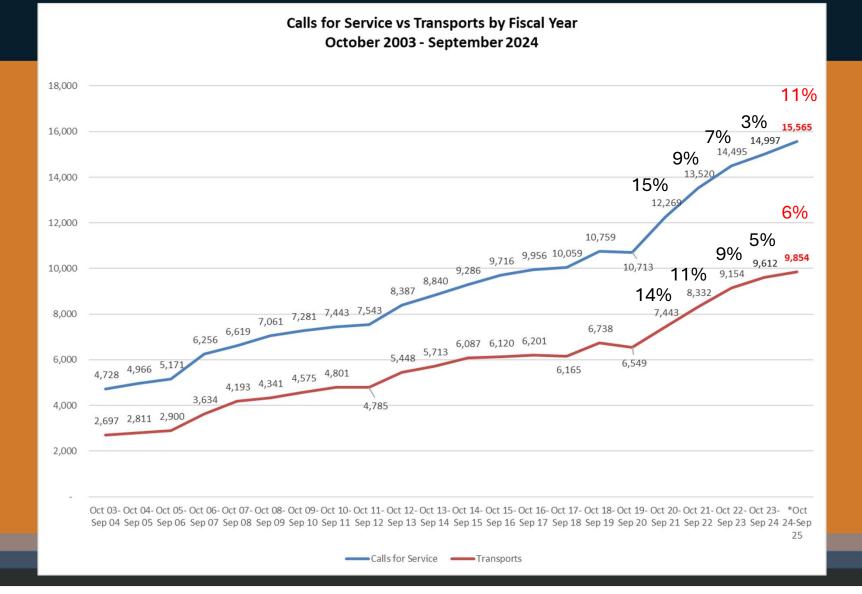

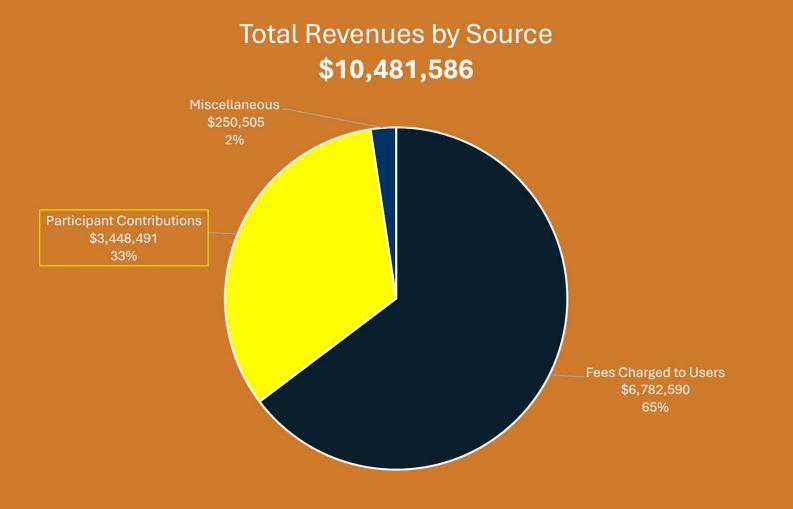

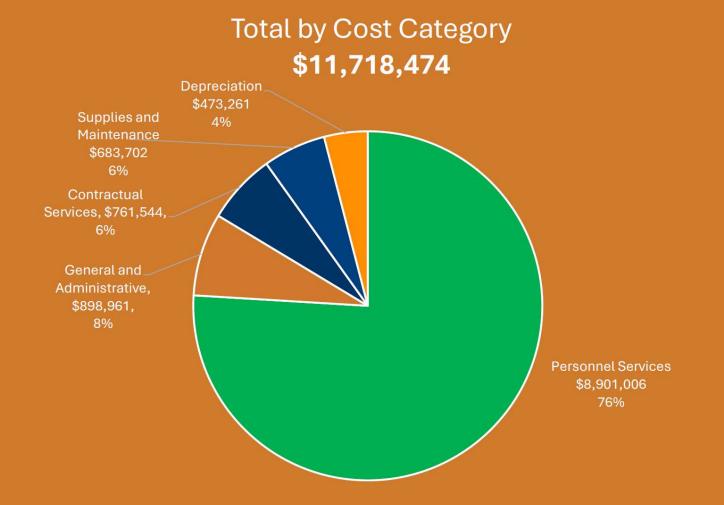

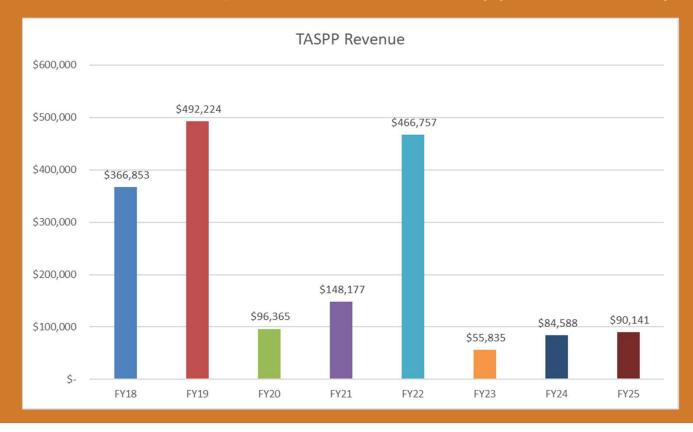

### Decrease in TASPP (Texas Ambulance Supplemental Payment Program)





- SB 2476 No Surprise Act
  - Banned ground ambulances from balance billing patient
    - TDI (Texas Division of Insurance)
  - ~(\$150-200K) decrease in ambulance revenue

  - (~\$780,000 shortfall)
