MINUTES CITY OF LAWNDALE PARKS, RECREATION AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, JULY 28, 2025

A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Vice Chairperson Wood called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm in the second-floor meeting room of the Harold E. Hofmann Community Center, located at 14700 Burin Avenue, Lawndale, CA 90260.

B. FLAG SALUTE

Commissioner Collins led the flag salute.

C. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

1. Approval of the Minutes from the June 9, 2025, Commission Meeting

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins and seconded by Vice Chairperson Wood to approve the June 9, 2025, minutes as written.

Motion carried 2-0, with Commissioner Owens abstaining and Commissioner Castro and Chairperson Miller absent.

E. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS – Items not on the agenda (Public Comments)

F. COMMENTS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Vice Chairperson Wood recommended that the Community Services Department have all communication offered in English and Spanish. She highlighted that she reviewed all of the social media content on the city's social media for the month and found that only 19% of the info was in both English and Spanish. She also mentioned that she streamed the previous council meeting to see the Parks Make Life Better proclamation. There were some follow up comments from staff and other commissioners that supported this request.

Commissioner Collins talked about her participation in the Yoga on the Lawn Program, and that she'd be in favor of continuing the program after August. She also reiterated her request for park reservations for parties.

G. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

2. Lawndale Beat Ridership Report for June 2025

Director Minter provided a brief update on the report, and highlighted the fiscal year numbers that were included in the packet. Vice Chairperson Wood made a motion to accept and file the Report. A second was made by Commissioner Collins.

Motion carried 3-0 absent Commissioner Castro and Chairperson Miller.

3. Commissioner Apparel

Director Minter briefly summarized the staff report and requested input from the Commissioners for apparel. There was some discussion about colors and styles, but ultimately the Commission supports a black polo shirt, simple design, cotton poly blend, with embroidery. Vice Chairperson Wood also requested that warmer options be provided, like a fleece or jacket, for the evening events when it would be cold.

4. Community Survey – Heart & Soul Music Festival

Director Minter reviewed the results of the surveys that were taken during the Music Festival. There were a few questions, and thoughts about how to improve future concerts and music festivals, with feedback from the Commissioners.
