#### A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Commissioner Gomez, filling in for the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:38 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 14717 Burin Avenue, Lawndale, CA 90260.

#### 1. Approval of the Minutes from the December 9, 2024, Commission Meeting

#### 3. Lawndale Beat – 2024 Statistics

Director Minter provided a presentation on the Lawndale Beat, the routes, and the data reported over the 2024 year. The presentation included a discussion on the evaluation of the current routes, potential destinations, and working with a consultant to evaluate the current system and get community input on changes to the current routes to make the Beat more effective and customer friendly. There were comments and suggestions from the Commissioners during the discussion, with more information to come at a later date.

Director Minter provided a brief review of Santa's Sleigh, and asked Commissioner Gomez for his thoughts on his time volunteering.
