1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Chairperson Loeza called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 14717 Burin Avenue, Lawndale, CA 90260.

2. FLAG SALUTE

Commissioner Gomez led the flag salute.

3. APPROVAL OF AUGUST 26, 2024, MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Woods and seconded by Commissioner Miller to approve the September 9, 2024, minutes as written.

5. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS – Items not on the agenda (Public Comments)

6. COMMENTS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Lin – Talked about the Blues Festival and that he was looking forward to the feedback from the community

Gomez – Talked about the Blues Festival and the Youth Development Center meeting that was held the past Saturday

Loeza – Asked about the surveys from the Blues Festival

Lin – Blues Festival, loved the game area

7. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

7A. Community Input for the Youth Development Center and Skatepark Project

Director Minter provided a presentation showing the brief history of the project so far, along with the Council selected option and talking points for the community. After the presentation, he turned it over to BOA architect Kyle Ng for some remarks, before summarizing and turning it back to the Commission.

Chairperson Loeza asked about the 20% contingency; Kyle responded, followed by dir. Minter; she asked about funding options, including the use of General Fund; she asked about programs that were considered, and if the powerpoint was available to the public; Vice Chair Miller asked about the display boards, and for Kyle to explain the dots; he then asked about the demographics of those in attendance at the community meeting on Saturday; Woods asked about getting a copy of the powerpoint slides (dir. Minter affirmed they would be sent out); Gomez asked if a breakdown of demographic info was available on who submitted the surveys; dir. Minter said they should get a breakdown by youth/parent; Lin thanked Kyle, and discussed the importance of the young people being heard; asked about a deadline for the surveys; asked about YouTube or Instagram for the updates; request career development for students; wanted to make sure students were engaged in the process; asked about the Youth Advisory Committee's priorities during their meeting;

Public Comment

Alexis asked about youth programs, and if there were opportunities to engage with and/or participate in the youth programs; staff discussed a variety of programs and options the city was already considering, but that public input was always welcome, including through the Youth Advisory Committee meetings;

Commissioners

Loeza asked about the ages of participants that would be allowed; dir. Minter responded middle and high school

Woods asked about security and staffing; dir. Minter responded that would be included in an operational plan that would be presented later to the Council

Gomez asked for a dumbed down version of how to implement a program; dir. Minter explained there are lots of ways to go about it, through Council, Commission, direct interaction at the center; emails, calls, etc.

Loeza thanked Kyle and staff

Miller thanked the guests in attendance

Lin asked about the architects familiarity with Teen Centers; Kyle responded; he then thanked Alexis for attending

There was no action taken on the Community Discussion.

Director Minter provided a summary of the Blues Festival, highlighting the bands, food, games, and spectators; he then thanked Public Works for all of their support in the setup and cleanup for the event, and thanked the CSD staff for their hard work throughout the planning process and during the event; He then talked about the implementation of the quarterly commission stipend payments that would begin in October;

RE: Approval of a Resolution Authorizing the use of the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission Trust Fund for Halloween Haunt Purchases

BACKGROUND

The Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission (PRSSC) annually contributes sales revenues from its fireworks stand fund-raising program to the PRSSC Trust Fund. The account was established in 2005 to allow the PRSSC to monitor its revenues and to make purchases that assist the City and the Community Services Department (formerly Parks and Recreation Department) to provide funding for special programs and events.

The purchasing policy, Section 3.10.020 of the Lawndale Municipal Code creates a framework to authorize the PRSSC to procure supplies, services and equipment (i) related to social services and events and (ii) for items not included in the City Budget, with the concurrence of a majority of the Commission.

STAFF REVIEW

Over the years the PRSSC has donated funds to the Community Services Department Halloween Haunt event and distributed free promotional items to children in attendance. During past meetings under Commissioner Comments a few of the Commissioners had requested that staff bring forward a request to authorize the use of PRSSC Trust Funds for the purchase of promotional items to be distributed at the 2024 Halloween Haunt event, including trick-or-treat bags and glow-in-the-dark necklaces.

The items that have traditionally been purchased include 1,000 glow-in-the-dark necklaces and 200 colorful trick-or-treat bags for children attending the event that do not have one. Recently staff were cleaning out a storage area and found more than 250 trick-or-treat bags from a previous event. Staff are recommending that these bags be used before the Commission uses funds to purchase new bags. These bags are colorful, have City of Lawndale printed on them, and are made of a paper product that is more sustainable than plastic bags. In addition, staff have found a bulk purchase of the glow-in-the-dark necklaces through Amazon which are available for \$385.80 including tax and shipping (Attachment A). Staff did find a large supply of glow-in-the-dark necklaces in storage as well, however they appear to be old and not effective at glowing.

Resolution 1100-24 is attached for the PRSSC to review and approve the use of funds as identified in the Resolution (Attachment B). This Resolution includes a not-to-exceed amount of \$400 for the purchase of glow-in-the-dark necklaces. As a similar staff report was included on the agenda for the October 14th meeting which was cancelled, staff placed the order in advance to ensure the glow necklaces would be available and delivered in time for the event. Per the Lawndale Municipal Code Section 3.10.020, the PRSSC is not required to solicit bids for purchases below the amount of \$2,500.

As staff have already made this purchase, the Commission would be approving a reimbursement to the City for funds spent. Should the Commission not approve the request, the expenditure would remain in the Halloween program and no reimbursement or transfer of funds would be completed. If approved, the funding transfer will be processed from the PRSSC Trust Fund to the applicable Community Services Department budget line item.

FUNDING

Sufficient funds are available in the PRSSC Trust Fund account to cover this request. The current balance of the PRSSC Trust Fund Account is \$34,773.82 (Attachment C).

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend that the Commission review and approve Resolution 1100-24 authorizing the purchase of glow necklaces for the 2024 Halloween Haunt event.

RESOLUTION NO. 1100-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAWNSDALE, CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF HALLOWEEN ITEMS TO BE GIVEN AWAY AT THE CITY'S 2024 HALLOWEEN HAUNT EVENT ON OCTOBER 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, Lawnsdale Municipal Code ("LMC") Chapter 3.10 establishes the procurement policies pursuant to which the City's Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission ("PRSSC") may spend the funds raised by the PRSSC's fireworks booth operations; and

WHEREAS, LMC Section 3.10.020 authorizes the PRSSC to procure supplies, services and equipment with funds raised by the PRSSC if a majority of the PRSSC approves the expenditure after considering the purchase as a properly agendaized item at a regular public meeting of the PRSSC; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024, at a regular meeting of the PRSSC, the PRSSC considered whether to authorize the expenditure of funds raised by the PRSSC for the purchase of 1,000 Glow-in-the-Dark necklaces to be given away free of charge to the children in the community at the 2024 Halloween Haunt Event to be held on October 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARKS, RECREATION AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LAWNSDALE, CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That the PRSSC has reviewed account statements demonstrating that PRSSC Fireworks Trust Fund Account includes sufficient funds to make the purchases being considered.

SECTION 3. That the PRSSC hereby approves the expenditure not to exceed \$400.00 of the funds raised by the PRSSC to purchase 1,000 Glow-in-the-Dark necklaces as selected by the PRSSC members to be given away free of charge during the City's 2024 Halloween Haunt Event to be held on October 31, 2024.

SECTION 4. That the PRSSC's staff liaison is hereby directed to undertake such actions as may be necessary to donate the funds contemplated herein on behalf of the PRSSC.

RE: Selection and Approval of the Date and Route to Volunteer in the Santa's Sleigh Event

The *South Bay 25 Club* is a service organization in the City of Lawndale that has been providing holiday cheer to the community for more than 40 years. One of the most popular holiday traditions for the *South Bay 25 Club* is Santa's Sleigh. The Santa's Sleigh visits take place throughout the City of Lawndale beginning the Monday after the *Angel Tree Lighting Event* at City Hall and run for 9 days (not including weekends).

This year's *Angel Tree Lighting Event* will be held on Friday, December 6, and will once again feature the *South Bay 25 Santa's Sleigh* as an attraction for families to come and take pictures with Santa and the elves. After the *Angel Tree Lighting Event*, Santa and the Elves will take the weekend to prepare before starting the Santa's Sleigh routes on Monday, December 9.

The South Bay 25 Club has once again requested the assistance of organizations in the City to help with Santa's Sleigh, including helping kids get safely to Santa's Sleigh and driving around in the lead car making announcements. As the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission has previously supported this holiday tradition, the *South Bay 25 Club* has asked if the Commission will once again commit to approximately 4 hours of service for 4 volunteers. As sign-ups have already begun, the Commission has the following options for providing assistance to Santa's Sleigh:

- Tuesday, December 10; Route 2 - 14 stops
- Wednesday, December 11; Route 3 - 18 stops
- Thursday, December 12; Route 4 - 14 stops

The approximate times of service will be from 5:30 pm to 9:00 pm, and could vary based on the number of stops and the date/route selected. The routes, stops, and maps have been included as an attachment to this report for your review.

Staff recommend that the Commissioners review the attached routes, stops, and maps and choose whether or not they would like to participate in the 2024 *South Bay 25 Club Santa's Sleigh*, and if so, select the date and route that would allow the Commissioners to assist with the night's activities.
