# **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:**

Staff is recommending the allocation of \$127,387.16 from the Parks Bond to fund the expansion of the parking lot located to the West of the Switchyard in Willow Creek Park. Tarrant County has agreed to build the lot and double it in size, adding an additional 82 spaces, with the condition that the City cover the cost of materials. Please see the attachment for the breakdown of material costs.

The expansion would provide additional parking spots and alleviate congestion caused by on-street parking along the streets surrounding the park.

The requested funds would only cover the cost of materials, totaling \$127,387.16

# **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the approval of the parking lot expansion at Willow Creek Park by funding the cost of materials to cost no more than \$127,387.16 and be taken from the Parks Bond.
