Model Mission Statement:

The Mission of the Traffic Safety Advisory Board (TSAB) is to provide community input to the City Manager, City Council, City Departments, and other boards and committees, on traffic safety issues in the city, including the safe, and efficient movement of vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians on streets, highways, and walkways.

Responsibilities and Functions:

The TSAB works collaboratively with City staff and citizens to review and respond to resident requests for improving vehicular and non-vehicular transportation routes within Saginaw. The TASB will be responsible for promoting enhanced traffic safety in the City of Saginaw by creating a forum where residents of the City can voice traffic concerns, suggestions, and requests, work with City staff to examine alternatives to existing traffic situations, and identify long and short term solutions to traffic safety in Saginaw. The Board may develop reports, proposals, and recommendations to Council and Staff. This Board is advisory only and will not have responsibility for any operational activities.
