

2022 Keep America Fishing and Johnson Outdoors Cleanup Challenge

Tournament Rules

TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION – Tournament registration must be completed through the Fishing Chaos App. For app downloads, visit <https://fishingchaos.com/>.
If you have Fishing Chaos loaded from prior tournaments, be sure to have the latest version of the app.

TOURNAMENT TIMES

- Catch and submission start: September 1st at 12:01 AM EDT
- Catch and submission end: September 30th at 11:59 PM EDT.

All photo/fish submissions must be completed and entered in the Fishing Chaos app by the end time. (No exceptions)

ENTRY FEE –

- Individual - \$25.00 (Required to participate in the KAF and JO Cleanup Challenge)
- Team Entry - \$500.00 (4 person teams)

COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- Competitor must have their own unique Fishing Chaos log in.
- Competitor must be 13 years old or older to compete.
- Competitor agrees to all tournament rules, Waiver and Release of Liability during registration of this event. Waiver and Release of liability is below.
- You must have a valid/current fishing license from the state you will be fishing in.
- Fishing must be done without the aid of a professional guide.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT – The Keep America Fishing virtual fishing tournament will be a Catch-Photo format tournament. The tournament will be facilitated through the Fishing Chaos app.

FISHING BOUNDARIES – Only public waters open to everyone are eligible.

The Black Bass Category is broken down into three regions:

- North Region – CT, DE, ID, IL, IN, IA, KS, ME, MA, MI, MN, MO, MT, NE, NH, NJ, NY, ND, OH, OR, PA, RI, SD, UT, VT, VA, WA, WV, WI, WY
- South Region – AL, AZ, AR, CO, GA, KY, LA, MD, MS, NE, NV, NM, NC, OK, SC, TN
- Big 3 Region – FL, TX, CA

FISHING METHODS AND TACKLE –

- Fishing from a boat, kayak, dock or shore is allowed

- You can have more than one rod per angler on the vessel or on your person, but you cannot fish with more than one rod at a time.
- Live and artificial bait can be used.
- Someone may assist you in baiting your hook and measuring the fish. It is your job to cast, hook, and land the fish.
- The fish submitted cannot be altered in any way. All fish must be alive and photographed immediately after they are caught.

IDENTIFIER – All tournament photo submissions must include the tournament identifier code in the photograph. The identifier code will be released on the event page at 7:00 PM EDT on 8/31/22. You may write the code on a piece of paper, your hand or use the identifier card found on the event page. The photo submission must include the identifier code in the photograph. NO EXCEPTIONS.

CATCH ENTRY – Your catch must be submitted into the Fishing Chaos app. Your phone must have location services turned on for the Fishing Chaos and Camera apps. If you are in an area that has no cell signal to make your submission, once you reach an area with signal, upload your photographs to the Fishing Chaos app.

CATCH ENTRY REVIEW – All catch entries will be reviewed and approved by a third-party tournament management company, including disputes. For tournament questions or to file a dispute email keepamericafishing-td@reeltn.co

MEASURING BOARD – The measuring board must be a hard flat surface with ¼” increments with a left fence, not homemade or a paper ruler. The board must be in good shape and all measurement increments clear. NO EXCEPTIONS.

FISH CATEGORIES, SCORING AND JUDGING CRITERIA

STRIPED BASS – Based on count. No length or weight entered.

- **COUNT** – All counts must be entered as follows to be approved by the judge:
 - For “count” enter the total amount of fish in the photo. Fishing Chaos will total the count for all submissions automatically.
 - May upload multiple fish in one photo.
 - Each photo submitted must be of different fish.
 - Each photo submitted must have the following visible in the photo:
 - Entire fish from HEAD to TAIL must be visible.
 - All fish must be facing left and laying on its side. Photos of fish positioned any differently will not be accepted. This is necessary to make sure duplicate fish are not being entered.
 - Identifier code clearly visible. The code can be written on your hand or paper. Photos with the code added digitally, after the photo is taken, will not be accepted.

BLACK BASS NORTH, SOUTH AND BIG 3 REGIONS - Individual anglers five longest black bass.

Black Bass Species consist of: Largemouth, Spotted, Bartram's, Mean Mouth, Guadalupe, Shoal and Smallmouth bass and any hybrid of the above are accepted.

CATFISH – Anglers longest three catfish. Maximum length allowed 30.00”.

Species include Blue, Bullhead, Channel, Flathead and White Catfish.

WALLEYE – Anglers longest three walleye. Maximum length allowed 30.00”.

SPECKLED TROUT – Anglers longest three speckled trout. Maximum length allowed 30.00”.

REDFISH – Anglers three longest Redfish within the slot limit of 16" to 28" in length, with one over slot (maximum length 30”).

TEAM BLACK BASS – Teams will consist of 4 anglers. The total score will be made up of each angler's largest bass.

MEASUREMENT – All measurements must be taken as follows:

- “Zero end” of the board to the left of the individual measuring the fish.
- Belly of the fish down towards the individual measuring the fish.
- The nose or mouth of the fish must be butted to the end stop of the board.
- Tail of the fish must sit within the side edges of the board. You may pinch the tail as necessary to keep the tail on the board. Judges will score based on where the tail touches or crosses the ¼” increment measurement on the board.
- You may not cover the eye or mouth of the fish.
- You may not cover the tail spot on redfish.
- Hand cannot be underneath the gill plate.
- Closed mouths are preferred.
- Judges may deduct up to 1” for open mouth if the mouth being open would result in increased length.
- Phot must be of the whole fish taken from directly above the fish.
- Do not lay the identifier on top of the fish.
- Fish may only be entered once. Each fish submitted must be a different fish.

ENTRIES - You may submit as many fish as you would like, the Fishing Chaos app will “cull” your smallest entries as fish are entered. (Does not apply to the Striped Bass Category) For Striped Bass, entries are cumulative based on count (total number of fish caught).

TIES – Black Bass: ties are broken by the biggest fish submitted. For all other categories ties will be broken based on the first angler to reach the highest score.

POLYGRAPH - All contestants agree to take a polygraph test if requested by Keep America Fishing or Reel Tournament Management. The test will be taken at a time and place chosen by the requesting party. Refusal to take the test or failing the test will result in disqualification of the angler from the event. The individual taking the test will be determined by the tournament director.

PENALTIES – Any angler found to have intentionally cheated in an attempt to defraud the tournament may be subject to criminal prosecution by the State they caught the fish in. Any angler found to have intentionally cheated in an attempt to defraud the tournament will also forfeit any awards they may have won and be banned from any future Keep America Fishing Tournaments.

DISPUTES – All tournament participants have the right to dispute the results or actions of any angler. To protest, you must present your written complaint to the Tournament Director no later than 15 minutes after the official close of the tournament fishing hours. Disputes should be emailed to keepamericafishing-td@reeltn.co .

SPORTSMANSHIP – Any angler, who displays poor sportsmanship, violates any Tournament Rule (s), or any state or local game laws may be disqualified. In addition, any act of an angler, verbal or physical, that reflects unfavorably upon Keep America Fishing’s effort to promote conservation, fishing, clean waters, courtesy, and safety may be reason for disqualification from this and all future Keep America Fishing tournaments. Keep America Fishing and Reel Tournament Management also reserve the right to refuse application of entry, with or without cause, at their sole discretion.

PRIZES – The highest three placing anglers in each category will receive a prize package. (See details below for Team Bass prizes) Standings will be finalized, and winners notified within 14 days from the tournament end date.

SUGGESTED PRACTICES

- Please handle all fish with respect and care. Use a Boga or fish gripping device to help handle your fish if needed.
- If you are having trouble measuring a fish, put it in a net or on fish grips and let it relax in the water for a minute.
- Wet your hands before handling your fish.
- We encourage bait fishermen to use circle hooks. This will allow for fewer deep hook ups and easier fish releases.
- Deep hooked fish – if you have a deeply hooked fish, we encourage you to simply cut your line, take your measurement, photograph, and release the fish.
- Videos will be posted showing proper measuring techniques along with do’s and don’ts. We encourage you to watch these.
- Videos will be posted on how to use the Fishing Chaos app.

JOHNSON OUTDOORS CLEANUP CHALLENGE RULES

While fishing in the Keep America Fishing Tournament, pick up any trash you find on the waterways. Take a photo of your trash bag or larger items that won't fit in a bag, upload the photo, and enter the estimated number of pieces in your bag. The more bags you enter the greater your chance at winning the Johnson Outdoors Clean Earth Challenge.

1 BAG/LARGE ITEM SUBMITTED = 1 ENTRY

To qualify, trash must be collected on waterways or other outdoor environments. Household garbage does not qualify. Please do your best to estimate the number of pieces of trash in your bag(s), however winners are not based on the total number of pieces collected.

PRIZES – The highest three placing anglers in each category will receive a prize package. Standings will be finalized, and winners notified within 14 days from the tournament end date.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT
