



**13th ANNUAL FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO  
OFFICIAL RULES  
2026**

1. THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO IS A MULTI-SPECIES, RECREATIONAL AND COMPETITIVE FISHING TOURNAMENT. THE OFFICIAL DATES ARE JUNE 5 - JUNE 6, 2026. THE OFFICIAL WEIGH STATION OF THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO IS AT THE BEACH BETWEEN FLORA-BAMA OLE RIVER GRILL & FLORA-BAMA YACHT CLUB.
  - ANY AMENDMENTS FOR THE 2026 FBFR ARE NOTED IN **RED** IN THE FOLLOWING RULE/INFORMATION
2. THE OFFICIAL SCHEDULE OF THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO (FBFR) IS:
  - VIRTUAL CAPTAINS MEETING** – **6 PM** THURSDAY, JUNE 4, 2026 ON THE FLORABAMA FISHING RODEO FACEBOOK PAGE
  - FISHING RODEO** – 12 AM FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026, TO **6 PM** SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 2026.
  - AWARDS CEREMONY** – 11AM SUNDAY, JUNE 7, 2026, AT THE FLORA-BAMA YACHT CLUB STAGE
3. OFFICIAL STARTING TIME OF THE FBFR IS 12:00AM CDT, FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026, AND CLOSING TIME IS **6:00PM** CDT, SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 2026. FISH MUST BE ENTERED AT THE OFFICIAL WEIGH STATIONS AT THE TIME ABOVE.
4. THE OFFICIAL BOUNDARIES TO FISH IN THE FBFR ARE FROM THE TX/LA BORDER TO CAPE SAN BLAS, FL.
5. ALL TICKETS MUST BE PROPERLY COMPLETED WITH THE REQUIRED INFORMATION AT THE TIME OF TICKET PURCHASE. ONLY REGISTERED ANGLERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES. REGISTRATION TICKETS MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE WEIGH STATION WHEN ENTERING A FISH FOR PRIZE COMPETITION DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF THE FBFR WEIGH STATION. TICKETS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE OR REFUNDABLE. ANGLERS MUST REGISTER BEFORE 12 AM ON FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 IN ORDER TO FISH THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO.

6. THERE ARE TWO DIVISIONS IN THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO, THE JUNIOR DIVISION (ANGLERS 12 YEARS AND YOUNGER) AND THE ADULTS' DIVISION (ANGLERS OF ALL AGES MAY PURCHASE AN ADULT TICKET). JUNIOR DIVISION TICKETS ARE \$25 PER ANGLER AND ADULTS ARE \$50 PER ANGLER. TICKETS CAN BE PURCHASED ONLINE AT [Florabama.com/fishing-rodeo](https://www.florabama.com/fishing-rodeo)
  - a. A JUNIOR MAY PURCHASE AN ADULT DIVISION TICKET ONLY OR PURCHASE A JUNIOR & ADULT DIVISION TICKET TO COMPETE IN BOTH DIVISIONS.
  - b. JUNIORS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO WIN THE TOP LADY ANGLER OR MASTER ANGLER PRIZES.
7. THE OFFICIAL WEIGH STATION HOURS OF THE FBFR ARE:  
**FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 FROM 2 PM-6 PM AND SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 2026 FROM 2 PM-6 PM**
8. ANY CAPTAINS PERMITTING A PERSON ON HIS / HER BOAT TO VIOLATE ANY RULE OF THE FBFR MAY CAUSE ALL PARTICIPANTS ABOARD HIS / HER BOAT TO BE DISQUALIFIED. EVERY PERSON ON EACH VESSEL FISHING THE FBFR MUST HAVE HIS/HER OWN TICKET UNLESS THE ANGLER IS A RECOGNIZED CAPTAIN OR DECKHAND NOT COMPETING FOR FBFR PRIZES.
9. A COPY OF THE RULES SHALL BE KEPT ON AND AVAILABLE TO ALL ANGLERS FISHING THE FBFR. VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. A FBFR DIRECTOR MAY DISQUALIFY ANY PARTICIPATE AT ANY TIME.
10. ANGLERS MAY ONLY WEIGH IN FISH ORIGINALLY CAUGHT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12 AM ON FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 TO **6 PM** SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 2026.
11. ANGLERS MAY NOT USE A GIG OR CAST NET TO CATCH A FISH.
12. ALL FISH MUST BE CAUGHT WITH A ROD & REEL OR A POLE AND LINE.
13. ANGLERS MAY BRING FISH TO THE WEIGH STATION VIA BOAT OR VEHICLE.
  - a. **ANGLERS IN THE KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP MUST BRING THEIR KING MACKEREL IN TO BE WEIGHED VIA BOAT.**
14. ANGLERS CAN ONLY WEIGH IN FISH THAT ARE ONE OF THE CATEGORIES DESIGNATED BY THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO LISTED ON PAGE 3 OF THIS DOCUMENT. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO WEIGH IN FISH NOT ON THE SPECIES LIST.
15. ALL VESSELS MUST BE IN EYESIGHT OF THE DOCKMASTER WHEN THE WEIGH STATION CLOSES TO BE ELIGIBLE TO WEIGH A FISH AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE WEIGH STATION. A BOAT'S ELIGIBILITY IS COMPLETELY UP TO THE DOCKMASTER ONCE THE WEIGH STATION IS CLOSED

16. ALL FBFR WINNERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY LARGEST FISH ENTERED ACCORDING TO WEIGHT, EXCEPT LIONFISH, WHICH WILL BE DETERMINED BY TOTAL NUMBER OF FISH BROUGHT TO THE WEIGH STATION AS WELL AS LARGEST AND SMALLEST CATCH.

17. AN ANGLER WILL BE PERMITTED TO HOLD AND WIN ONLY ONE PLACE PER CATEGORY AT ANY ONE TIME, BUT MAY PLACE IN MORE THAN ONE CATEGORY SIMULTANEOUSLY.

18. THERE ARE **12 CATEGORIES FOR THE JUNIOR DIVISION**, WHICH INCLUDE:

21. ALL BLUE CRABS ARE JUDGED ON WEIGHT AND MUST BE CAUGHT BY ROD & REEL, HANDLINE OR CRAB BASKET. CRAB TRAPS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
22. THE LIONFISH IS A SPEARFISHING CATEGORY. THERE ARE 3 WINNING PLACES WITHIN THIS CATEGORY: MOST QUANTITY, LARGEST, & SMALLEST.
23. IN THE SPEARFISHING CATEGORY, 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, & 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED FOR LARGEST AGGREGATE WEIGHT OF A PARTICIPANTS LARGEST RED SNAPPER, GROUPER, AND FLOUNDER CAUGHT DURING THE FBFR. SPEARED FISH CANNOT BE ENTERED IN OTHER CATEGORIES. PARTICIPANTS MAY ONLY USE ONE RED SNAPPER, ONE GROUPER, AND ONE FLOUNDER TO APPLY TO THEIR TOTAL AGGREGATE WEIGHT.
24. IN ORDER TO WEIGH A RED DRUM IN THE FBFR, THE FISH MUST BE IN ACCORDANCE TO THE ALABAMA SLOT REGULATION, 16 INCHES TO 26 INCHES IN LENGTH. **ANGLERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO WEIGH IN A RED DRUM OUTSIDE THE ALABAMA SLOT.**
25. ANGLERS MAY WEIGH IN ANY SPECKLED TROUT THAT MEASURES OVER 15 INCHES.
26. ALL FISH WILL BE WEIGHED USING FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO OFFICIAL SCALES.
27. ALL FISH ENTERED INTO COMPETITION MUST BE CAUGHT BY THE ANGLER REGISTERING THE FISH AND IT MUST BE CAUGHT WITH A ROD AND REEL OR A POLE AND LINE (EXCEPT SPEARFISHING & LIONFISH CATEGORIES). NO ANGLER SHALL BE ASSISTED IN ANY WAY TO LAND HIS OR HER FISH EXCEPT FOR HELP IN NETTING OR GAFFING HIS / HER CATCH. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
28. THE TOP LADY ANGLER AWARD WILL BE AWARDED TO THE FEMALE ANGLER WITH THE MOST POINTS IN THE ADULTS' DIVISION. (SCALE: 1<sup>ST</sup> - 3PTS, 2<sup>ND</sup> - 2PTS, 3<sup>RD</sup> - 1PT.)  
\*IN CASE OF A TIE FOR TOP LADY ANGLER, THE ANGLER WHO WEIGHED IN A FISH FIRST WILL BE AWARDED THE PRIZE.
29. A MASTER ANGLER AWARD WILL BE AWARDED TO THE ANGLER WITH THE MOST POINTS IN THE ADULTS' DIVISION. (SCALE: 1<sup>ST</sup> - 3PTS, 2<sup>ND</sup> - 2PTS, 3<sup>RD</sup> - 1PT.)  
\*IN CASE OF A TIE FOR MASTER ANGLER, THE ANGLER WHO WEIGHED IN **FIRST** WILL BE AWARDED THE PRIZE.

30. ALL ANGLERS MUST ABIDE BY STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS IN THE LOCATION THAT THEY ARE FISHING.
31. THE FBFR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO HOLD ALL FISH WEIGHED INTO THE FBFR. THOSE FISH NOT HELD BY THE FBFR MUST BE REASONABLY DISPOSED OF OR HANDLED BY THE ANGLER.
32. ALL WINNERS ARE SUBJECT TO POLYGRAPH AND ALL FISH ENTERED ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY A MARINE BIOLOGIST ON SITE. ALL ANGLERS WHO REFUSE TO TAKE OR FAIL A POLYGRAPH WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

40. ANY MATTER NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED BY THESE RULES MAY BE DECIDED BY AND AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE FBFR PRESIDENT. ALL DECISIONS SHALL BE FINAL. ALL RULE INTERPRETATIONS SHALL COME FROM THE FBFR PRESIDENT.

2. THE ADDITIONAL COST TO ENTER THE FBFR KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP IS **\$250.00 PER TEAM.**
3. ALL ANGLERS FISHING IN THIS CHAMPIONSHIP MUST POSSESS THEIR OWN FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO **JUNIOR OR ADULT DIVISION TICKET.** BOATS AND ANGLERS ON EACH BOAT MUST BE REGISTERED BY 12 AM FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 TO COMPETE IN THE FBFR KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP.
4. **SIGN OUT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR COMPETITIVE DIVISIONS.**
5. ALL RULES, WEIGH STATION HOURS & DOCK PROCEDURES OF THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO APPLY TO THE FLORA-BAMA KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP.
6. ANGLERS IN THE KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP MUST BRING THEIR KING MACKEREL IN TO BE WEIGHED VIA BOAT.
7. THE OFFICIAL BOUNDARIES TO FISH IN THE FBFR ARE FROM THE TX/LA BORDER TO CAPE SAN BLAS, FL.
8. TEAMS COMPETE FOR A 90% PAYOUT OF ENTRIES: 1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE – 50% / 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE 30% / 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE 20% CASH PRIZES.
9. ALL KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP WINNERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY LARGEST FISH ENTERED ACCORDING TO WEIGHT.
10. A TEAM WILL BE PERMITTED TO HOLD AND WIN ONLY ONE PLACE IN THE KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP.
11. ANGLERS MAY ONLY WEIGH IN FISH ORIGINALLY CAUGHT BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12 AM ON FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 AND **6 PM SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 2026.** **KING MACKEREL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO BRING THEIR FISH TO THE WEIGH STATION VIA BOAT.**
12. ANGLERS MAY NOT WEIGH IN FISH CAUGHT BY ANOTHER ANGLER. DOING SO WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.

13. ANGLERS MAY NOT WEIGH IN A FISH ORIGINALLY CAUGHT PRIOR TO 12AM JUNE 5, 2026. DOING SO WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.
14. ALL VESSELS MUST BE IN EYESIGHT OF THE DOCKMASTER WHEN THE WEIGH STATION CLOSES TO BE ELIGIBLE TO WEIGH A FISH AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE WEIGH STATION AT 7PM ON JUNE 6, 2026. A BOAT'S ELIGIBILITY TO WEIGH A FISH IS COMPLETELY UP TO THE DOCKMASTER ONCE THE WEIGH STATION IS CLOSED.
15. AWARDS AND CASH PRIZES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE 13th ANNUAL AWARDS CEREMONY ON SUNDAY, JUNE 7, 2026. **ALL CHECKS AND PRIZE WINNINGS MUST BE REDEEMED BY JUNE 13, 2026. INDIVIDUALS PICKING UP CHECKS MUST PROVIDE VALID ID & FILL OUT APPROPRIATE FORMS TO RECEIVE THEIR CHECK.**

2. THE ADDITIONAL COST TO ENTER THE FBFR OFFSHORE SLAM CHAMPIONSHIP IS \$1,000.00 PER TEAM.
3. ALL ANGLERS FISHING IN THIS CHAMPIONSHIP MUST POSSESS THEIR OWN FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO **ADULT** DIVISION TICKET. TEAMS AND ANGLERS FISHING ON EACH TEAM MUST BE REGISTERED BY 12 AM FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026 TO COMPETE IN THE FBFR OFFSHORE SLAM CHAMPIONSHIP.
4. **NO SIGN OUT IS REQUIRED.**
5. ALL RULES, WEIGH STATION HOURS, AND DOCK PROCEDURES OF THE FLORA-BAMA FISHING RODEO APPLY TO THE FLORA-BAMA OFFSHORE SLAM CHAMPIONSHIP.
6. THE OFFICIAL BOUNDARIES TO FISH IN THE FBFR ARE FROM THE TX/LA BORDER TO CAPE SAN BLAS, FL.
7. TEAMS COMPETE FOR CASH PRIZES, IN WHICH 90% OF ENTRIES WILL BE PAID OUT TO THE TOP THREE PLACES. 1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE - 50% / 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE - 30% / 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE 20%
