And you know the way to the place where I am going." Thomas said to him,

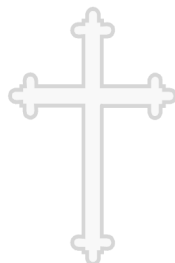
"Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?"
