NZQA QUALIFICATIONS

The New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) qualifications (currently approved for delivery in Kuwait and New Zealand) comprise core compulsory standards representing the competencies required by students, and endorsements recognising the specialised application within the sector. Students who enrol in these qualifications can achieve both the ICAO course certificates and NZQA certificate and diplomas.

These programmes are delivered face-to-face either in New Zealand or at an approved international academy, such as at the University of Kuwait in Kuwait City (each location is subject to NZQA approval).

STUDY IN NEW ZEALAND

Airways Training's Study Abroad programmes give air traffic services students the opportunity to add an international experience to their education, at world-leading training establishments in New Zealand.

This is a unique experience for students who want to experience living in New Zealand, immerse themselves in the English language, and gain expert training from some of the best ATC/Air Traffic Management (ATM) instructors in the world.

Most students who study with us are selected by the ANSP in their home country. Our courses are approved to meet their licensing requirements, for issue of an air traffic control licence.



There are some points to note before you can study air traffic control training in New Zealand:

- Visa availability: The New Zealand Government has paused issuing new student visas, therefore it is unlikely that you will be able to study with us at our academy in New Zealand at this time. However, we can keep your details and get in touch, if this status changes.
- For individual students: you'll need to check with the ANSP in your country to see if they will recognise our qualifications, and allow you to work in your own country.
- You can only train to work in New Zealand as an air traffic controller, if you are a New Zealand resident or Australian citizen.

*You can study the ICAO 051 Licensing Subjects course through AKO, our virtual training academy. This course is a theoretical pre-requisite that must be completed before beginning any simulation courses, for example aerodrome control or surveillance control.

Campus and facilities
