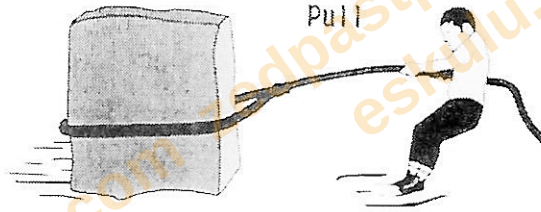

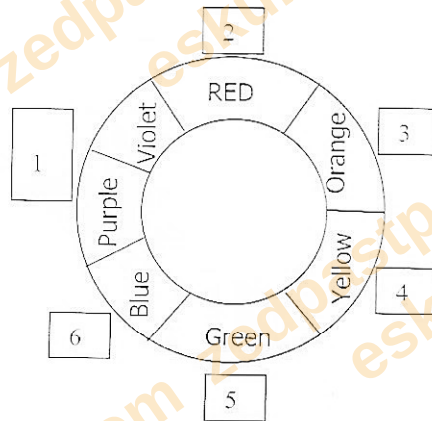

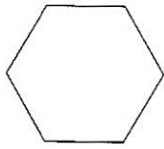

Answer: B -- scissors.

Question 12. Study the colour wheel diagram (Red at top, going clockwise through Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Purple/Violet, with six numbered boxes 1-6 sitting on the boundaries between adjacent colour segments). Which of the two colours when combined will produce a tertiary colour?

Best-effort judgment call -- without a fully legible scan of each numbered box's fill colour, the exact intended pair cannot be pinned down with certainty; boxes sitting on a primary/secondary boundary are the ones that combine to a tertiary colour.

Answer: C -- 2 and 4.

Best-effort judgment call -- key B points to the leftmost memory-related key (MRC), matching "Memory recall" among the given options.

Answer: C -- Memory recall.
