In exercise of the power conferred by section 25 of the West Bengal Shops and Establishments Act, 1963 (West Bengal Act XIII of 1963), the Governor is pleased hereby to make, after previous publication as required by sub-section (1) of the said section, the following amendment to the West Bengal Shops and Establishments Rules, 1964, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules):-

Amendment

In the said rules, for rule 55, substitute the following rule :-

“55. Special registers and records. (1) Any employer and shopkeeper can maintain and keep any register or record in respect of the persons employed by him in any form either manually or electronically, notwithstanding that it is not in accordance with the form provided in that behalf in these rules, subject to the condition that particulars required to be shown in any register or record under these rules are maintained or reflected therein.

(2) In case of any disparity or doubt, as may be raised by any person employed, inspector, employer or shopkeeper as to whether the particulars as required to be maintained in the register or record are properly reflected or not, the decision of the registering authority shall be final.
