The Aims of GCSF

- 1 To promote both sustainable corporate principles and practices
- 2 To recognize corporations who excel at sustainable development
- 3 To continue to develop global standards of corporate sustainability
- 4 To acknowledge the multifaceted nature of sustainability issues
- 5 To foster concern within global business community for CSR and CS issues

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), otherwise known as the Global Goals, are a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that all people enjoy peace and prosperity.

The SDGs provide clear guidelines and targets for all countries to adopt in accordance with their own priorities and the environmental challenges of the world at large. The SDGs are an inclusive agenda. They tackle the root causes of poverty and unite us together to make a positive change for both people and planet. “Poverty eradication is at the heart of the 2030 Agenda, and so is the commitment to leave no-one behind.

2019 Global Corporate Sustainability Forum (GCSF) represents a valuable occasion to discuss opportunities and challenges in corporate sustainability bringing together practical and academic communities around the world.

The GCSF, hosted by Alliance for Sustainable Development Goals (A·SDGs), is a cross-disciplinary event which comprises two award ceremonies, and 16 parallel sessions for broader discussions on corporate sustainability. The Global Corporate Sustainability Awards (GCSA)-Professional, Best Practice and Reporting Awards are presented to outstanding international corporations and professionals to recognize their achievements in corporate sustainability. Taiwan Corporate Sustainability Awards (TCSA) is presented to domestic corporations in honor of their success in implementing corporate sustainability in various categories. Sessions and workshops on different topics relating to corporate sustainability are organized by several professional organizations including BSI Taiwan, Deloitte Taiwan, EY Taiwan, PwC Taiwan, ICLEI Southeast Asia Secretariat, Center for Corporate Sustainability (CCS), Taiwan Institute for Sustainable Energy (TAISE), Taiwan Academy of Corporate Sustainability (TACS), Taiwan Alliance for Sustainable Supply (TASS), MSCI, Green University Union of Taiwan (GUUT), CSRone, CTCI Education Foundation (CTCIEF) and College of Business, National Taipei University.

The forum is expected to reach the scale of 2,700 participants congregating delegates, speakers, participants, and audiences from more than 10 countries. This forum does not only strive to promote corporate sustainable development but also to facilitate knowledge and exchange opinions among domestic and international experts.

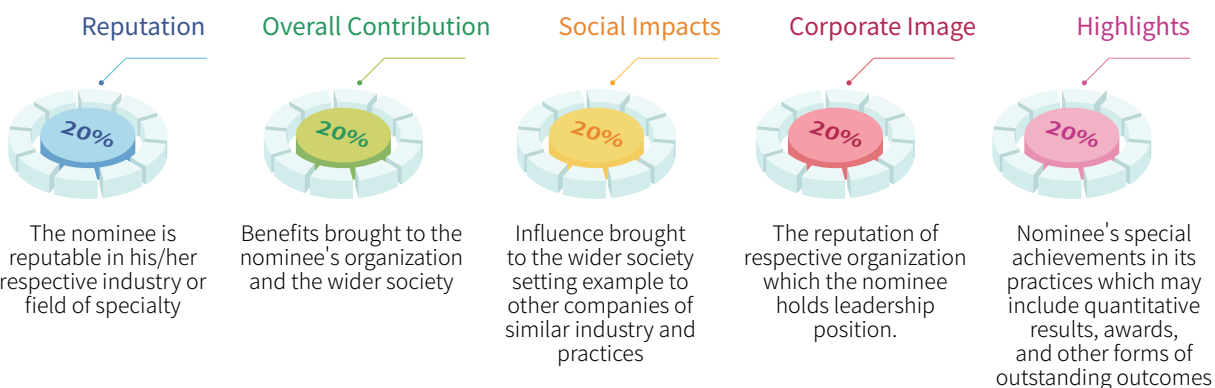

Use of own company developed unique global IP by using IoT (Internet of Things) technology through cloud based servers. The technology agnostic innovation helped the organisation to move towards pre-emptive and predictive maintenance thereby increasing 'ease of use'. Monitoring of consumption data for qualitative (TDS, temperature, hardness, Fluoride, Iron, Arsenic, and pH) and quantitative (litres of water dispensed per day) monitoring makes pre-emptive maintenance possible thereby increasing efficiency in the operations. Respective stake-holders are able view the information through a dedicated portal and a mobile app which helps in providing fully managed service contracts. The IT platform also supports cashless transacting through QR codes, RFID cards and digital transacting through 122 e-wallets using digital touch-screen user interface. 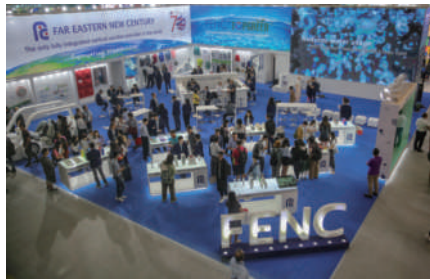

Outstanding Practice (Emerging Market)

Act Locally, Inspiring Globally: Empowering Anak Dalam Tribe Through Innovative Social Forestry for Better Life

PT Pertamina Hulu Energi (PHE), a subsidiary of PT Pertamina (Persero) – Indonesia's State-Owned Oil and Natural Gas Corporation, through its subsidiary PHE Jambi Merang, exercised an extraordinary program that nurture a tribal community through empowerment of 'Anak Dalam Tribe'. The tribal community considered as left behind, underdeveloped and outermost as laid out in Bahasa Indonesia terminology.

The Anak Dalam tribe is located along a riverbank that goes through a peatland with access into their location by car for about 5 hours from Bayung Lencir, South Sumatera and additional distance by a small boat through the river for more than 4km. They live in the heart of Muara Medak forest, on the border of South Sumatra and Jambi, Indonesia.



Anak Dalam tribal community consists of 79 individuals from very few remaining groups which have been trying to make a living as hunters and gatherers and well depending from nature from generation to generation. They live in small groups and move around occasionally to find new hunting and fishing ground as well as gathering woods for cooking.

The condition encouraged PHE through PHE Jambi Merang to pay extra attention on tribal communities through the empowerment of Anak Dalam tribe. The program focuses on economic empowerment, improving education and health, community advocacy to obtain self-legality, and in 2018, prioritizing the innovation of the concept of Social Forestry Area in the form of forest area utilization to support people's lives from various aspects and at the same time guarding the surrounding forest area.

The program focuses to achieve 'Decent Life Changes' without leaving local wisdom, by placing the Anak Dalam Tribal Community as the subject of change. The result of the SROI calculations provided social benefits worth than IDR3,29 in total for PHE and other stakeholders. The program also involves multi-stakeholder synergy such as local government, Ministry of Environment and Forestry through the Forest Management Unit (KPH) Lalan Mendis, NGO, and other stakeholders.

Great Practices (World Class)

E.SUN Golden Seed Project



E.SUN committed on caring for children in remote areas and hope to provide these children with an environment where they may learn and grow in joy and happiness. Therefore, E.SUN decided to initiate "E.SUN Golden Seed Project", which aims to improve the reading environments of children in elementary schools in remote areas or those with limited resources by building heart-warming, comfortable E.SUN Libraries. VIP cardholders of E.SUN Bank World MasterCard is in line with the Golden Seed Project, and it was the first world MasterCard with charitable function, featuring innovative approaches to linking the two ends of an M-shaped society in Asia. For every purchase made by the card, 0.3% of every card consumption will be donated to improve libraries' environment and supplement new books, assisting children in improving adaptability and competency. E.SUN has established 144 libraries in June 2019, and continued toward the next milestone of 200 E.SUN Libraries construction.

(3) Motivate employees to be involved and expand awareness: Epson employees from various departments volunteer to help set up and run the Fantas Aquarium. The company encourages their participation in these events, which are held during working hours. Employees who have participated as volunteers report that the experience changed their outlook on life or gave them extra motivation at work.

L'Oréal Taiwan Promoting Women in Science Program

According to UNESCO data, women account for only 28% of the world's scientists.
