


LESSON ONE

Attention Grabber

Today, we begin a wonderful **adventure** with a Magic Team that live and play in a town called Smilesville. Smilesville needs the help of the Magic Team because the newspaper **announced** that there is a Bad Bug on the loose who is causing **decay** in the children's teeth. The Magic Team has the power to get rid of the Bad Bug but only if the children help. Who is the Magic Team? What are their powers? Who is the Bad Bug and how can the children help? Listen to the story to see if you have the answers.



Story To Share

Smilesville's dentist, Dr. Clean, is a very smart man. He knows things other people don't know. One day, Billy Brush, Polly Paste and Riley Rope were at Dr. Clean's office getting their teeth cleaned. While they were there, Dr. Clean showed them the newspaper. The headlines read, "Children Warned about a Tooth Bug." As Billy Brush, Polly Paste and Riley Rope read the newspaper article, they learned that this bad and dirty tooth bug's name was Diggy Decay. The newspaper said that Diggy had been found living in the mouths of many children. At night, and sometimes during the day, Diggy would snack on the children's teeth. Dr. Clean was very worried that if Diggy kept snacking on the children's teeth, they wouldn't have any left. It was then that Dr. Clean told Billy Brush, Polly Paste and Riley Rope something that they would never forget.

"I was hoping that the children of Smilesville would learn to take care of their teeth on their own, but it looks like they need your help. You three are not like other children. You have magical powers," he said.

Billy Brush, Polly Paste, and Riley Rope all together said, "huh?" They could not believe what they were hearing.

Dr. Clean said, "Yes, and because you have these magical powers, it is your duty to help the children not only in Smilesville, but all over the world."







The magic team looked at each other in disbelief, and then all at once they smiled and said, "No problem! What do we need to do?"

Dr. Clean told them that their **mission** was to run Diggy Decay out of town. The magic team thought for a while, and then Polly Paste said, "How do we do that if we don't know whose mouth Diggy lives in?"

Wise Dr. Clean said, "There are two ways to find Diggy Decay. One, you must find out who Diggy's friends are because they are the ones who make him so powerful, and two, you must get the children's help." LESSON TWO

Who are Diggy Decay's Friends?

Attention Grabber and Review

Last week the Magic Team met at Dr. Clean's office and he told them that they had the magical powers to run Diggy Decay, the bad bug, out of town. Dr. Clean told the Magic Team there were two things they would have to do to find Diggy Decay. One, they needed to find out who Diggy's friends were; and two, they needed to get the help of the children.

Story To Share

Since Diggy likes to snack on teeth, the magic team decided to meet at Dr. Clean's Office the next day. Dr. Clean is a dentist, and dentists are experts who know how to keep teeth clean and healthy. Dr. Clean was helping a patient when the magic team arrived at his office, so the team sat down in the waiting room and they reread the newspaper article about Diggy Decay. The article said that Diggy is a very sneaky bug who has lots of friends that help him destroy teeth.

When Dr. Clean got finished with his patient, he came in the room. "Hi Billy Brush, Polly Paste, and Riley Rope, did you get a good night's sleep?"

"Yes, Dr. Clean, but we are dying to find out who Diggy Decay's friends are," said Riley Rope.

"Bad snacks," said Dr. Clean.

"Bad snacks? What is a bad snack?" they asked.

Dr. Clean told the magic team that candy and sodas were Diggy's best friends. When children eat or drink these bad snacks, the candy or the sugar from the soda gets stuck on their teeth. Once this happens, they invite Diggy to come over. When Diggy gets there, he and his friends work together to dig holes in teeth and these holes are called **cavities**. Dr. Clean explained to the team that part of his job is to fix these cavities, and he would really like to see Diggy run out of town.

Billy Brush, still wondering how they could possibly find Diggy Decay asked, "Dr. Clean, we now know who Diggy Decay is, and we know who his friends are, but how are we possibly going to find him? There has to be a bazillion children in the world, and probably half that many in Smilesville alone."





Dr. Clean said, "Oh, don't worry about that Billy Brush. I have a big secret that I will tell you all tomorrow, but before I tell you, I want you to think about how we could work together to keep Diggy Decay out of the mouths of children. If he couldn't get into the mouths of the children, don't you think that he would leave town?"

What do Diggy and his friends do to teeth?

(dig holes)

What do you think the secret is?

(answers will vary)

LESSON THREE

Attention Grabber and Review

Last week, Dr. Clean told the Magic team that Diggy Decay's friends are bad snacks, things like candy and sodas. He also told them that he had a secret that was going to help the Magic Team. Let's listen to find out the secret.

Story To Share

Dr. Clean was talking to his secretary the next day when the Magic Team showed up.

"What is the secret, Dr. Clean? Is it going to help us?"

"Settle down, Billy Brush. Let's have a seat. Remember how I told you that you all had magical powers? Well, the secret is that you each have your own special powers."

"Special powers! What do you mean?" they exclaimed.

"Well, Billy Brush, you are like a magic wand. Your job is to use your powers to scrub teeth to get them clean. Polly Paste, you are a magic potion that makes teeth sparkle and you give Billy extra power."

"Cool Billy, I give you extra power." Polly said.

Riley jumped up, "What about me? What are my magical powers? Who do I help?"

"Well, Riley Rope, you help Billy and Polly both. You see, Billy and Poly work together to clean the teeth and tongue, but Diggy is so sneaky he has learned how to survive their cleaning. Story To Share

Polly said, "If we can teach the children of Smilesville what they need to do at home to keep their mouths clean, what kinds of food or snacks they should always eat, and how important it is to visit their dentist, Diggy will want to run out of town on his own, we won't have to make him."

"Silly Billy, we don't go to every house. Where can we find all of the children together and ready to learn?"

LESSON FIVE

Last week, the magic team decided to go to the schools to teach the children about their magical powers, and how they could use them to run Diggy out of town. Let's see if it worked.

Attention Grabber and Review

The next day, the magic team went to the school to talk to all of the students. They introduced themselves to the students. "How many of you have heard of Diggy Decay? He is a bug who lives in some of your mouths. He digs very deep holes in your teeth. Sometimes, he digs so much that your teeth fall out. He is a very bad bug that we need to run out of town, and you are the only ones who can make that happen. We are here to teach you how and to help you run Diggy out of town."

"There are three things that you can do to keep your teeth clean at all times," Polly said. "First, there are three basic items for you to use everyday when you are at home."

"They are a toothbrush, toothpaste and floss," Billy continued. "What do you think I am?"

Everyone in the class responded, "A toothbrush!"

Polly said, "And me, what do you think I am?"

Everyone in the class responded, "Toothpaste!"

Then Riley said, "And what about me?"

The class responded, "Floss!"

The team then told the students, "We are called the Magic Team because each of us has magical powers. Our powers help you to keep your mouths clean. Each of you must use the Magic Team everyday. Second, you should eat good snacks that Diggy Decay doesn't like such as fruit and vegetables. You should also drink lots of water. Third, you must visit the dentist. Now that you all have made the pledge, the mayor is having a town meeting that we must all go to."

When the magic team and the children arrived, the town square was packed with all of the people of Smilesville. The mayor was standing in front of everyone. "Attention town's people," he said, "the Magic Team and the children of Smilesville have successfully run Diggy Decay out of town. I am officially making all of the children of Smilesville Magic Team Deputies. Each one of you will receive a badge to show that you know what it takes to keep your mouths clean and healthy. 







The friendly dentist can stop Diggy Decay.








Put an X on Diggy's friends. Circle The Magic Team's friends.




Diggy Decay makes my teeth sad.















Riley Rope cleans between the teeth.





What will The Magic Team give you?








Draw me and my teeth.

I pledge to eat healthy food and snacks.


