This privacy notice for Homesty Limited ("Company", "we", "us", or "our"), describes how and why we might collect, store, use, and/or share ("process") your information when you use our services ("Services"), such as when you:

- Download and use our mobile application (Homesty) on iOS, or any other application of ours that links to this privacy notice.
- Engage with us in other related ways, including any sales, marketing, or events.

1. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

Personal information you disclose to us.

In Short: We collect personal information that you provide to us.

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you register on the Services, express an interest in obtaining information about us or our products and Services, when you participate in activities on the Services, or otherwise when you contact us.

Personal Information Provided by You. The personal information that we collect depends on the context of your interactions with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use. The personal information we collect may include the following:

- names
- phone numbers
- email addresses
- mailing addresses

- job titles
- usernames
- passwords
- contact preferences
- contact or authentication data
- billing addresses
- debit/credit card numbers
- personal income
- birthday / date
- any other information provided by you

Sensitive Information. When necessary, with your consent or as otherwise permitted by applicable law, we may process the following categories of sensitive information:

- financial data
- biometric data
- creditworthiness data
- student data

Payment Data. We may collect data necessary to process your payment if you make purchases, such as your payment instrument number (such as a credit card number), and the security code associated with your payment instrument. All payment data is stored by Stripe or NatWest. You may find their privacy notice link(s) here: TBD.

Social Media Login Data. We may provide you with the option to register with us using your existing Apple ID, Google account, or your social media account details, like your Facebook, X, or other social media account. If you choose to register in this way, we will collect the information described in the section called "HOW DO WE HANDLE YOUR SOCIAL LOGINS?" below.

Application Data. If you use our application(s), we also may collect the following information if you choose to provide us with access or permission:

- **Geolocation Information.** We may request access or permission to track location-based information from your iOS device, either continuously or while you are using our mobile application(s), to provide certain location-based services. If you wish to change our access or permissions, you may do so in your device's settings. We may obtain and store on your device ("cache") your location for up to three (3) months.
- **Mobile Device Access.** We may request access or permission to certain features from your iOS device, including your mobile device's camera and other features. If you wish to change our access or permissions, you may do so in your device's settings.
- **Mobile Device Data.** We automatically collect device information (such as your iOS device ID, model, and manufacturer), operating system, version information, and system configuration information, device and application identification numbers, browser type and version, hardware model, Internet service provider and/or mobile carrier, and Internet Protocol (IP) address (or proxy server). If you are using our application(s), we may also

collect information about the phone network associated with your mobile device, your mobile device's operating system or platform, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device's unique device ID, and information about the features of our application(s) you accessed.

- **Push Notifications.** We may request to send you push notifications regarding your account or certain features of the application(s). If you wish to opt out from receiving these types of communications, you may turn them off in your device's settings.

This information is primarily needed to maintain the security and operation of our application(s), for troubleshooting, and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes.

All personal information that you provide to us must be true, complete, and accurate, and you must notify us of any changes to such personal information.

Information automatically collected

In Short: Some information — such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address and/or browser and device characteristics — is collected automatically when you visit our Services.

We automatically collect certain information when you visit, use, or navigate the Services. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information) but may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use our Services, and other technical information. This information is primarily needed to maintain the security and operation of our Services, and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes.

Like many businesses, we also collect information through cookies and similar technologies.

The information we collect includes:

- **Device Data.** We collect device data such as information about your computer, phone, tablet, or other device you use to access the Services. Depending on the device used, this device data may include information such as your IP address (or proxy server), device and application identification numbers, location, browser type, hardware model, Internet service provider and/or mobile carrier, operating system, and system configuration information.
- **Location Data (iOS-Specific Adaptation)**

We collect location data from your device, which can be either precise or imprecise. The amount and type of location data we collect depend on the settings of your iOS device. For example, we may use GPS and other technologies to collect geolocation data that indicates your current location (based on your IP address or GPS data). You can opt-out of allowing us to collect this information by refusing access when prompted or by disabling Location Services in your iOS device settings. However, please note that opting out may limit certain functionalities of the Services that rely on location data.

2. HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR INFORMATION?

In Short: We process your information to provide, improve, and administer our Services, communicate with you, enhance security and fraud prevention, and comply with legal obligations. Additionally, we may process your information for other purposes with your consent.

We process your personal information for various purposes, depending on your interaction with our Services, including:

- **To facilitate account creation and authentication, and otherwise manage user accounts.** We process your information to enable account creation, login, and to maintain your account's functionality.
- **To deliver and facilitate the delivery of services to the user.** We process your information to provide the services you request.
- **To respond to user inquiries and offer support.** We process your information to address your inquiries and resolve potential issues with the services you request.
- **To send administrative information.** We process your information to send details about our products and services, updates to our terms and policies, and other relevant information.
- **To fulfill and manage your orders.** We process your information to handle your orders, payments, returns, and exchanges made through the Services.
- **To enable user-to-user communications.** We process your information if you choose to use features that allow for communication with other users.
- **To save or protect an individual's vital interest.** We process your information when necessary to protect an individual's vital interests, such as to prevent harm.

3. WHAT LEGAL BASES DO WE RELY ON TO PROCESS YOUR INFORMATION?

In Short: We only process your personal information when we believe it is necessary and when we have a valid legal reason (i.e., legal basis) to do so under applicable law, such as with your consent, to comply with laws, to provide you with services, to fulfill contractual obligations, to protect your rights, or to fulfill our legitimate business interests.

For users located in the EU or UK:

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and UK GDPR require us to explain the valid legal bases we rely on to process your personal information. We may rely on the following legal bases:

- **Consent:** We may process your information if you have given us permission (i.e., consent) to use your personal information for a specific purpose. You can withdraw your consent at any time.
- **Performance of a Contract:** We may process your personal information when it is necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations to you, including providing our Services or at your request before entering into a contract with you.
- **Legal Obligations:** We may process your information when it is necessary to comply with legal obligations, such as cooperating with law enforcement, exercising or defending our legal rights, or disclosing your information as evidence in litigation.
- **Vital Interests:** We may process your information when necessary to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of a third party, such as in situations involving potential threats to safety.

For users located in Canada:

We may process your information if you have given us specific permission (i.e., express consent) or in situations where your permission can be inferred (i.e., implied consent). You can withdraw your consent at any time.

In certain exceptional cases, we may be legally permitted under applicable law to process your information without your consent, such as:

- If collection is clearly in the interests of an individual and consent cannot be obtained in a timely way.
- For investigations, fraud detection, and prevention.
- For business transactions under certain conditions.
- If it is contained in a witness statement and necessary for assessing, processing, or settling an insurance claim.
- For identifying injured, ill, or deceased persons and communicating with next of kin.
- If we have reasonable grounds to believe that an individual may be a victim of financial abuse.
- If it is reasonable to expect that collecting and using the information with consent would compromise the availability or accuracy of the information, and the collection is reasonable for investigating a breach of an agreement or a contravention of Canadian laws.
- If disclosure is required to comply with a subpoena, warrant, court order, or rules of the court.
- If the information was produced by an individual in the course of their employment, business, or profession, and the collection is consistent with the purposes for which the information was produced.
- If the collection is solely for journalistic, artistic, or literary purposes.
- If the information is publicly available as specified by regulations.

4. WHEN AND WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

In Short: We may share your information in specific situations described below and/or with the following third parties.

We may need to share your personal information in the following scenarios:

- **Business Transfers:** We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by another company.
- **When Using Google Maps Platform APIs:** We may share your information with certain Google Maps Platform APIs (e.g., Google Maps API, Places API). To learn more about Google's privacy practices, please refer to their Privacy Policy here. We use these APIs to retrieve information when you make location-specific requests. This may involve obtaining and storing your location on your iOS device ("cache") for up to three (3) months. 9. HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE?

In Short: We aim to protect your personal information through a system of organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect your personal information. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is completely secure. Therefore, we cannot guarantee absolute security, and you share your information at your own risk. 10. DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?

In Short: We do not knowingly collect data from or market to children under 18 years of age.

We do not knowingly solicit data from or market to children under 18 years of age. 12. CONTROLS FOR DO-NOT-TRACK FEATURES
