In Belgium, the weather is very variable. In summer, there are temperatures around 20°C, the maximum is 32°C and the minimum is around 15°C. In winter, there's sometimes snow, but not often, and temperatures around 5°C. In autumn and spring the weather will vary a lot, with lots of rain, sometimes snow or very sunny days. The best thing you can do is to check the weather forecast before travelling to Belgium.
