Communication challenges discussed at IIT-BHU meet

Varanasi: The Indian Institute of Technology (Banaras Hindu University) is looking forward to open a centre to solve the new complications in the field of communication.

A meeting of IIT-BHU director Prof Pramod Kumar Jain and chairman of the Digital Communications Commission, department of telecommunication, ministry of communications, Aruna Sundararajan was held at IIT-BHU on Thursday to discuss the utility of telecommunication technology and the challenges of communications.

The main objective of the meeting was to find a solution to meet policy objectives under the Central government's 'National Digital Communication Policy -2018' through an interaction with the industry and academics.

Giving an account of the meeting, dean (research and development) of the institute Prof Rajiv Prakash said that with the help of the department of telecommunications and Indian Telephone Industry Pvt Ltd (ITI), a consensus has been reached on opening a center in the institute for mutual access to the expertise and facilities to solve the challenges of communication.

He said that research and development in both the institutions would be of great help in new research while it will also encourge opening and upliftment of startups, he said.

Possible technical tie-ups for new products/technology, offering facilities at ITI for prototype building and to offer the facilities at ITI for the startups were among other issues discussed in the meeting. Representatives from IIT Kanpur, MNNIT Allahabad, IIIT Allahabad, JK Institute Allahabad and IIT Patna also participated in the meeting.
