IIT-BHU goes up 8 notches, gets 11th rank

Varanasi: Indian Institute of Technology, Banaras Hindu University (IIT-BHU) improved its position from 19 to 11 in the engineering category of the 4th edition of National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF India Rankings 2019), declared by President Ram Nath Kovind in New Delhi on Monday.

The Banaras Hindu University has also retained its third position in the list of top universities in the country for the third consecutive year.

"We have gone up nine ranks this year and are on 11th position. We aim to see IIT-BHU in top-10 in NIRF ranking next year," said IIT-BHU director Prof. Pramod Kumar Jain.



The institute scored 68.61 points in teaching, learning and resource

More emphasis would be given to knowledge update, research, development and innovation for further improvement in ranking, he added.

He said that the institute scored 68.61 points in teaching, learning and resource (TLR), 45.63 points in research, pro-

fessional practice and collaborative performance (RPC) and 77.36 points in graduation outcome (GO). The total number of outreach & inclusivity (OI) is 53.16. The institute's scores have improved in all categories compared to previous year.

"It is our objective to take care of four important factors in ranking and achieve better goals. The academic level would be fully updated. Emphasis would be on research, publication and innovation while sponsored resources and consulting projects would be promoted. Also, we will focus on startups," he said.

According to NIRF records, IIT-BHU received 14th ranking in 2016 with 74.39 score points, 31st in 2017 with 49.92 score and 19th in 2018 with 56.62 score.
