## PROVISIONS

Issuance of this certificate shall not be construed as excusing the holder thereof from compliance with any applicable federal, state, or local statutes, ordinances, or regulations including those administered by local agencies under the Shoreline Management Act of 1971.

This authorization to make use of public waters of the state is subject to existing rights, including any existing rights held by the United States for the benefit of Indians under treaty or otherwise.

Some of the lands described herein are benefited by existing water rights. Therefore, the quantities of water granted under this right will be reduced by any quantities that may be used upon those lands by authority of those existing water rights.

The entire opening of the diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than 0.125 (1/8) inch. Water approach velocity to the screen shall be less than 1 foot per second and approaching 0.5 foot per second, as measured one foot in front of the screen.

This authorization to use public waters of the state is classified as a Family Farm Certificate in accordance with Chapter 90.66 RCW (Initiative Measure No. 59). This means the land being irrigated under this authorization shall comply with the following definition: Family Farm - a geographic area including not more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands, whether contiguous or noncontiguous, the controlling interest in which is held by a person having a controlling interest in no more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands in the State of Washington which are irrigated under water rights acquired after December 8, 1977. Furthermore, the land being irrigated under this authorization must continue to conform to the definition of a family farm.

*The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.*

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.

## CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF GROUND WATER CERTIFICATE NO. 4973-A

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 263, Laws of Washington for 1945 and the regulations of the Department of Ecology.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the U. S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Mines, Spokane, Washington has complied with all of the requirements of the Revised Code of Washington 90.44.100 and the regulations of the Department of Ecology, and is hereby granted the right to change the place of use of 25 gallons per minute, 2 acre feet per year.

That the use of such water is for continuous domestic supply in the amount of 25 gallons per minute, 2 acre feet per year.

That the points of withdrawal are two wells located within the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 30, T. 27 N., R. 40 E.W.M., Spokane County.

That the present place of use is within the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$ NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 30, T. 27 N., R. 40 E.W.M.

That they are authorized to change the place of use of 25 gallons per minute, 2 acre feet per year for continuous domestic supply to a 21.5 acre parcel at the approximate center of Sec. 36, T. 27 N., R. 39 E.W.M., within the abandoned missile site complex, Lincoln County, Washington.

## Certificate of Ground Water Right

Issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 263, Laws of Washington for 1945, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That U.S. ARMY ENGINEER DISTRICT  
 of Seattle, Washington, has made proof  
 to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of  
 the ground waters of a two (2) wells  
 located within REISM  
 Sec. 30, Twp. 27 N., R. 40 E. W.M.,  
 for the purpose of domestic supply  
 under and subject to provisions contained in Ground Water Permit No. 6530 issued by the State  
 Supervisor of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said ground waters has been perfected  
 in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water  
 Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 10 at page 4973-A;  
 that the right hereby confirmed dates from July 16, 1962; that the quantity of ground  
 water under the right hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually  
 beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 50 gallons per minute; 27 acre-feet  
per year for domestic supply.

Special provisions required by the Supervisor of Water Resources: \_\_\_\_\_

A description of the lands to which such ground water right is appurtenant:

A parcel in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec.30, T.27 N., R.40 E.W.M., described as: Beginning at a point north 46°28'14" east 2138.63 feet from the southwest corner of said Sec.30; thence south 50°14'10" east 80.66 feet; thence south 39°45'50" west 110.00 feet; thence north 50°14'10" west 160.0 feet; thence north 39°45'50" east 110.0 feet; thence south 50°14'10" east 79.34 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.40 of an acre, more or less.

The right to the use of the ground water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
