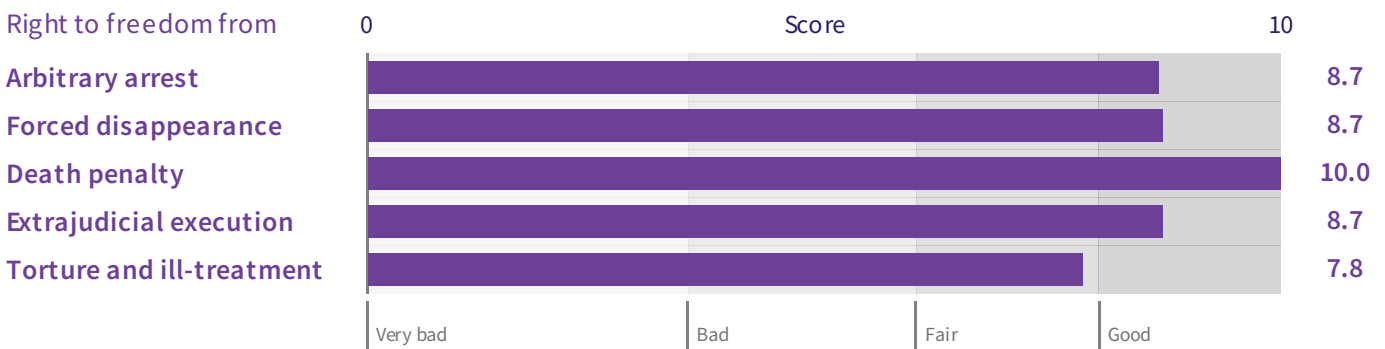

The Cook Islands' Safety from the State score of **8.4 out of 10** suggests that while most people are safe from government abuse, some may have experienced one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution or extrajudicial killing.

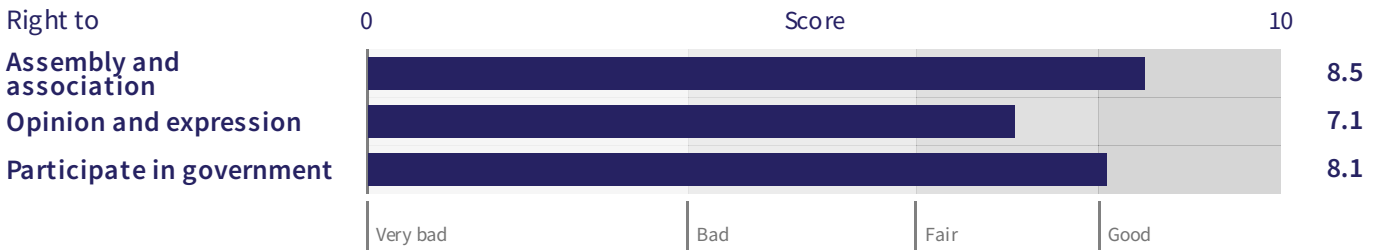
Compared with the other countries in the Pacific, the Cook Islands are performing **close to average** on the right to be safe from the state.

How well is the Cook Islands' government respecting each right?



The Cook Islands' Empowerment score of **7.9 out of 10** suggests that while many people are enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, and democratic rights), a significant number are not.

Compared with the other countries in the Pacific, the Cook Islands are performing **close to average** on empowerment rights.
