



How well is Jordan's government respecting each right?





Jordan's Safety from the State score of **7.6 out of 10** suggests that **a significant number of people are not** safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution, or extrajudicial killing.

For civil and political rights, we don't have sufficient data across Middle East and North Africa countries to allow for a regional comparison. However, when compared to the other countries in our sample, Jordan is performing **better than average** on the right to be safe from the state.



Jordan's Empowerment score of **5.5 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, democratic rights, and religion and belief).

For civil and political rights, we don't have sufficient data across Middle East and North Africa countries to allow for a regional comparison. However, when compared to the other countries in our sample, Jordan is performing **close to average** on empowerment rights.
