Liberia's Safety from the State score of **6.0 out of 10** suggests that a significant number of people are not safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution or extrajudicial killing.

For the civil and political rights we do not have data for enough countries in Sub-Saharan Africa to do a regional comparison. However, compared to the other countries in our sample, Liberia is performing **close to average** on the right to be safe from the state.

## Empowerment Civil and Political Rights (2022) How well is Liberia's government respecting each right? Right to 0 Score 10 Assembly and association Opinion and expression 5.8

Liberia's Empowerment score of **5.4 out of 10** suggests that many people are not enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, and democratic rights).
