



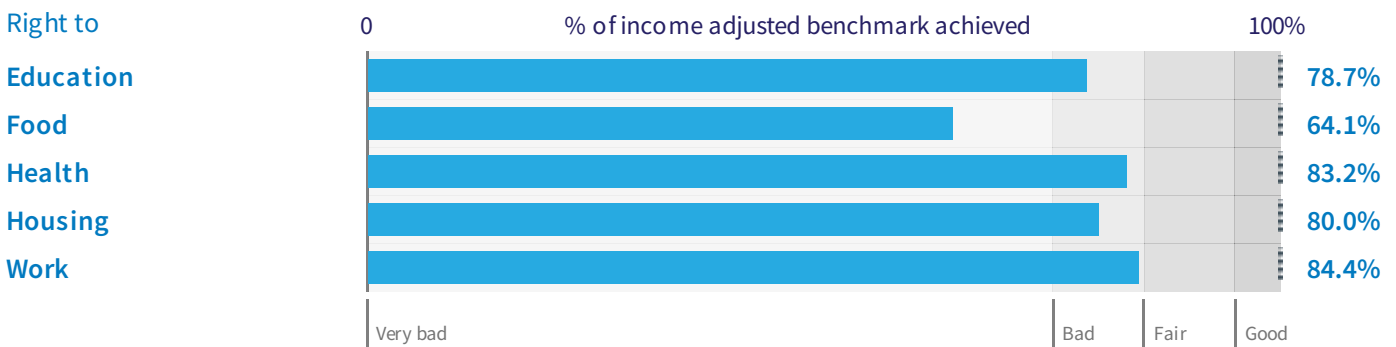

Nepal scores **78.1%** on Quality of Life when scored against the 'Income adjusted' benchmark.

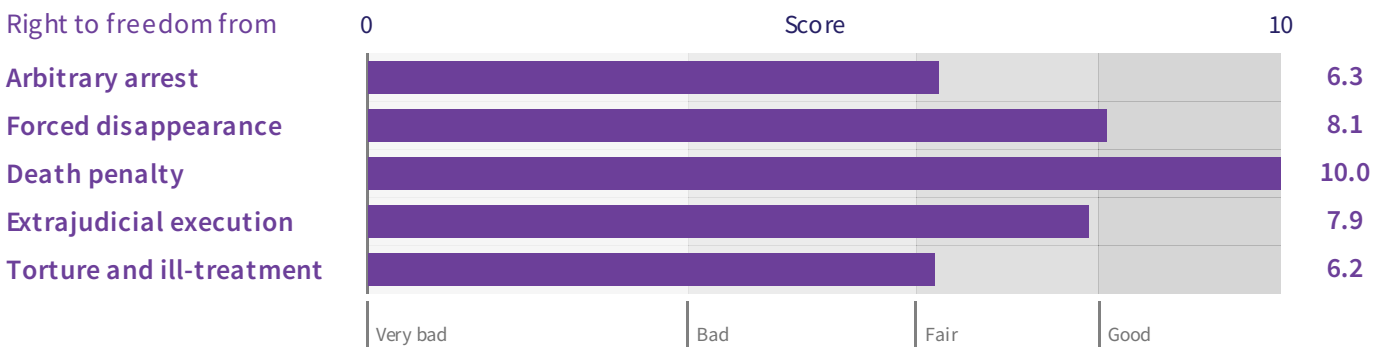

Safety from the State

Summary score **7.5 /10**

Civil and Political Rights (2022)

How well is Nepal's government respecting each right?



Nepal's Safety from the State score of **7.5 out of 10** suggests that a significant number of people are not safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution or extrajudicial killing.

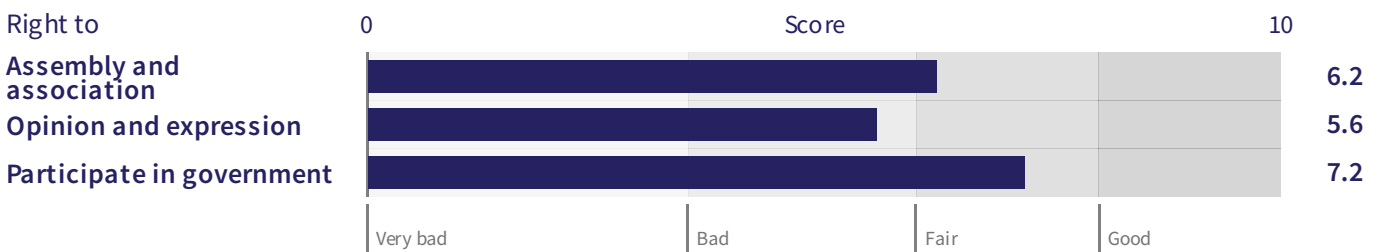
For the civil and political rights we do not have data for enough countries in South Asia to do a regional comparison. However, compared to the other countries in our sample, Nepal is performing **better than average** on the right to be safe from the state.

Empowerment

Summary score **6.3 / 10**

Civil and Political Rights (2022)

How well is Nepal's government respecting each right?



Nepal's Empowerment score of **6.3 out of 10** suggests that while many people are enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, and democratic rights), a significant number are not.

For the civil and political rights we do not have data for enough countries in South Asia to do a regional comparison. However, compared to the other countries in our sample, Nepal is performing **close to average** on empowerment rights.
