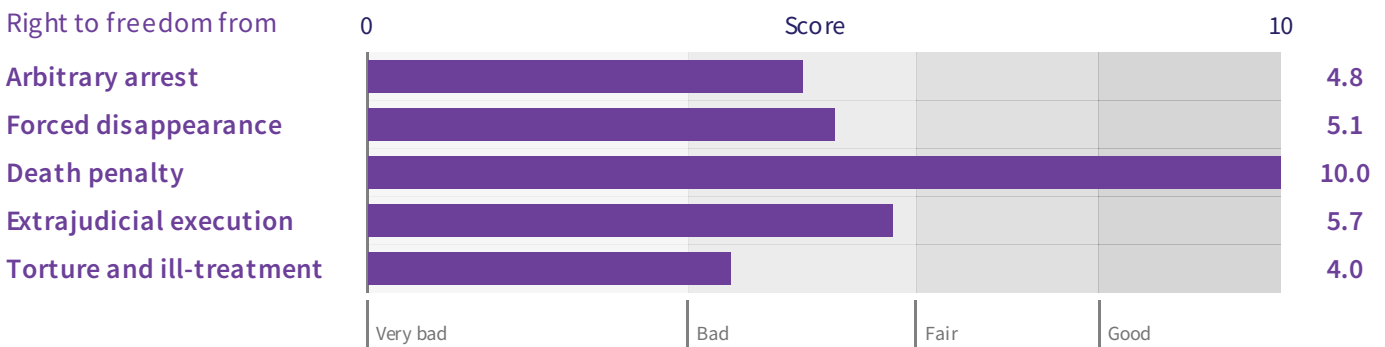

How well is Venezuela's government respecting each right?



Venezuela's Safety from the State score of **4.7 out of 10** suggests that many people are not safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution or extrajudicial killing.

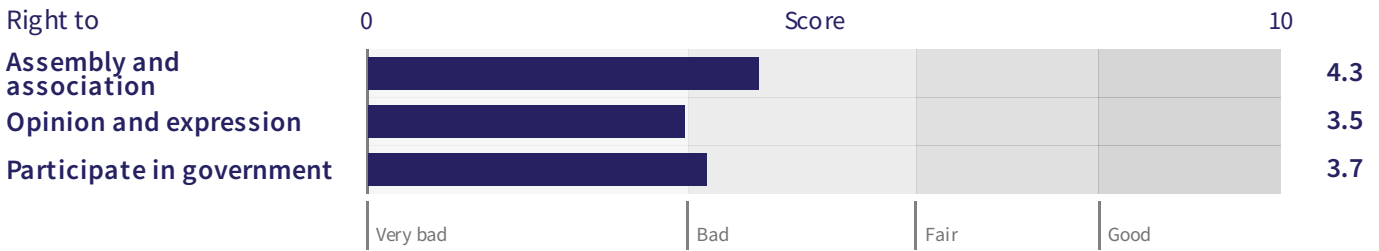

How well is Venezuela's government respecting each right?



Venezuela's Empowerment score of **4.0 out of 10** suggests that many people are not enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, and democratic rights).
