Vietnam's Safety from the State score of **4.9 out of 10** suggests that many people are not safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution or extrajudicial killing.

For the civil and political rights we do not have data for enough countries in East Asia and Pacific to do a regional comparison. However, compared to the other countries in our sample, Vietnam is performing **worse than average** on the right to be safe from the state.

Vietnam's Empowerment score of **2.7 out of 10** suggests that many people are not enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, and democratic rights).
