Vanuatu scores **76.8%** on Quality of Life when scored against the 'Income adjusted' benchmark.

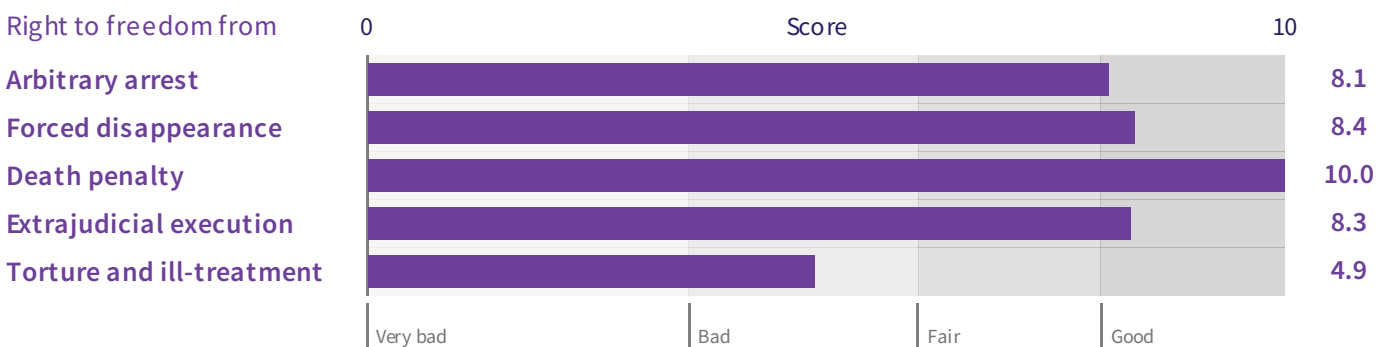

Vanuatu's Safety from the State score of **7.6 out of 10** suggests that a significant number of people are not safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution, or extrajudicial killing.

Compared with the other countries in the Pacific, Vanuatu is performing **close to average** on the right to be safe from the state.
