

Mexico's Safety from the State score of **3.2 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution, or extrajudicial killing.

For civil and political rights, we don't have sufficient data across Americas countries to allow for a regional comparison. However, when compared to the other countries in our sample, Mexico is performing **lower than average** on the right to be safe from the state.

How well is Mexico's government respecting each right?



Mexico's Empowerment score of **5.2 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, democratic rights, and religion and belief).
