

The Marshall Islands score 80.6% on Quality of Life when scored against the 'Income adjusted' benchmark.

Compared with the other countries in the Pacific, the Marshall Islands are performing **close to average** on Quality of Life rights (this comparison is calculated using the 'Income adjusted' benchmark).

How well is the Marshall Islands' government respecting each right?





The Marshall Islands' Safety from the State score of **5.5 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution, or extrajudicial killing.

Compared with the other countries in the Pacific, the Marshall Islands are performing **lower than average** on the right to be safe from the state.
