Venezuela's Safety from the State score of **3.4 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** safe from one or more of the following: arbitrary arrest, torture and ill-treatment, forced disappearance, execution, or extrajudicial killing.

For civil and political rights, we don't have sufficient data across Americas countries to allow for a regional comparison. However, when compared to the other countries in our sample, Venezuela is performing lower than average on the right to be safe from the state.



Empowerment

How well is Venezuela's government respecting each right?



Venezuela's Empowerment score of **2.7 out of 10** suggests that **many people are not** enjoying their civil liberties and political freedoms (freedom of speech, assembly and association, democratic rights, and religion and belief).

For civil and political rights, we don't have sufficient data across Americas countries to allow for a regional comparison. However, when compared to the other countries in our sample, Venezuela is performing **lower than average** on empowerment rights.
