Located just north of London, High Leigh benefits from excellent travel links by road, rail and air.

By road

High Leigh is seven miles from the M25

- From Junction 25, take the northbound A10 dual carriageway towards Hertford.
- Leave the A10 at the junction for Hoddesdon and follow the road towards the town.
- At the roundabout take the third exit signed 'Town Centre' (alongside Morrisons).
- Turn right at the church into Pauls Lane and bear left into Taverners Way.
- Take the first right into Lord Street and continue up the hill for just under a mile.
- High Leigh is on the left.

By rail

Our local Railway station is Broxbourne

There is a regular service from London Liverpool Street, which also connects with the Underground Victoria Line at Seven Sisters or Tottenham Hale. Trains also operate from Cambridge and Stansted Airport.

The station is two miles from the Centre, but there are plenty of taxis at reasonable rates (typically £12-£14).

Bus Transfer

There is now a local bus that operates from Broxbourne Station to the High Leigh housing estate, close to the conference centre. Get off the bus at the High Leigh **Lilywhites Lane** stop and walk through the estate (footpaths only) to High Leigh Conference Centre on Lord Street. It is best to use Google Maps to direct you when you arrive at the bus stop.

Walking

For anyone who wants to get their steps in before or after an event, it is possible to walk from Broxbourne Station to High Leigh (the walk is very nice, along a river and through a park) it takes between 30-40 minutes to complete. To High Leigh, the walk is uphill. On the return, it is downhill.

By air

Our local airport is Stansted

Stansted Airport is 40 minutes away by road or a 35 minute train journey from Broxbourne. Stansted is connected to around 200 cities in Europe and the Middle East.

We are close to **London City Airport** with connections to European capitals. The airport is around 60 minutes by train (DLR and Greater Anglia) to Broxbourne Station.

London Heathrow is around 1 hour 30 minutes by train (Elizabeth Line & Greater Anglia) to Broxbourne Station.
