ABSTRACT

Mastoiditis is a typical side effect of acute otitis media. Mastoiditis is a condition in which the mastoid air cells in the temporal bone become inflamed. The mastoid air cells, which connect the middle ear chamber to the outside world, are epithelium-lined bone septations. Children are more susceptible to middle ear infections than adults, therefore they have a larger risk of developing acute mastoiditis.^[1]

INTRODUCTION^[2]

Acute mastoiditis was rather prevalent among children. Because the air cells in the mastoid are related to the middle ear, the fluid collection and infection processes in the mastoid and middle ear are typically the same. The frequency of acute mastoiditis has decreased to only 1.2-2.0 instances per 100,000 person-years in countries with high prescription rates, because to early and frequent treatment of acute otitis media.

PATHOPHYSIOLOGY^[2]

In typical acute mastoiditis, purulent exudates collect in mastoid air cells, producing pressure that may lead to bone erosion and the formation of abscess-like cavities, which can be seen on CT scans.

CLINICAL FEATURES^[2]

Pain, erythema, and edoema of the mastoid process, as well as pinna displacement, are characteristic signs and symptoms of an acute middle ear infection in this patient.

The patient may suffer catastrophic repercussions if the infection penetrates through the periosteum of the temporal bone, generating a subperiosteal abscess, or erodes through the mastoid tip, causing septic thrombosis of the lateral sinus.




