Known for their paralyzing effect on the nervous system. They weaken brain and heart functions, leading to blood decomposition, changes in muscle tissue, and localized tissue death due to gangrene. Initially, anxiety, mental agitation, and heightened sensitivity of the brain, accompanied by hallucinations and fear are developed after which nervous depression, that range from weakness seen in serious illnesses to mental confusion, stupor, delirium, and paralysis. The snakes have been both one of the oldest and most grandiose mythological figures, as well as have immense importance in the realms of medicine and Hindu philosophy.

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# INTRODUCTION

The snake's venom is stored in a sac behind its fangs, with a small groove on the fangs connected to a tube that channels the poison. When the snake is threatened, it opens its mouth, extends its fangs, and the venom is released into the wound. The effects of the venom depend on factors such as the snake's anger, the potency of the venom, whether the fang passes through clothing (which could absorb some poison), and the victim's resistance to the venom. Thus, the effect of snake venom can be sort out in three forms.<sup>[1]</sup>

### 1. Lightning stroke

This demonstrates the unrestrained and lightning-fast effect of the poison, as the victim, immediately after being bitten, shows a look of anguish before collapsing and dying instantly.

### 2. Weakness and septicaemic

Symptoms resembling septicaemia, characterized by an increased heart rate that gradually weakens in tone and strength. This is followed by nervous system depression, leading to a typhoid-like state and ultimately resulting in death."

## 3. Nervous phenomenon

Vertigo, dark spots in the vision, blindness, a distinct tremor throughout the body, a dazed expression, difficulty breathing, and even noisy respiration. In slower cases, patient experience weakness after the initial symptoms, with the wound becoming dark or gangrenous. Discharges become foul-

smelling. The patient may develop dysenterylike symptoms and a typhoid-like condition, eventually leading to a weak, critical state and death.

- o Lachesis Notable for recurring intermittent fevers each spring.
- o Crot-h Many symptoms are characterised by their periodic nature.
