**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioner's Court of Travis County, Texas: That the acceptance for maintenance by Travis County, Texas of the roads or streets in real estate subdivisions does not obligate the County to install street marking signs as this is considered to be a part of the developer's construction. But that erected signs for traffic control, such as for speed limits and stop and yield signs shall remain the responsibility of the County.
