Form: verb + **-ed**

We use **the Past Simple Tense** for actions which happened at a stated time in the past.

*She **played** tennis yesterday. (When? **Yesterday.**)*

How we form verbs in the Past Simple Tense:

- verbs ending in **-e + -d** : *like – liked*
- verbs ending in **a consonant + y** → **-ied** : *cry – cried*
- verbs ending in **a vowel + y + -ed** : *play – played*
- verbs ending in one stressed vowel between two consonants, **double the last consonant + -ed** : *stop – stopped*
