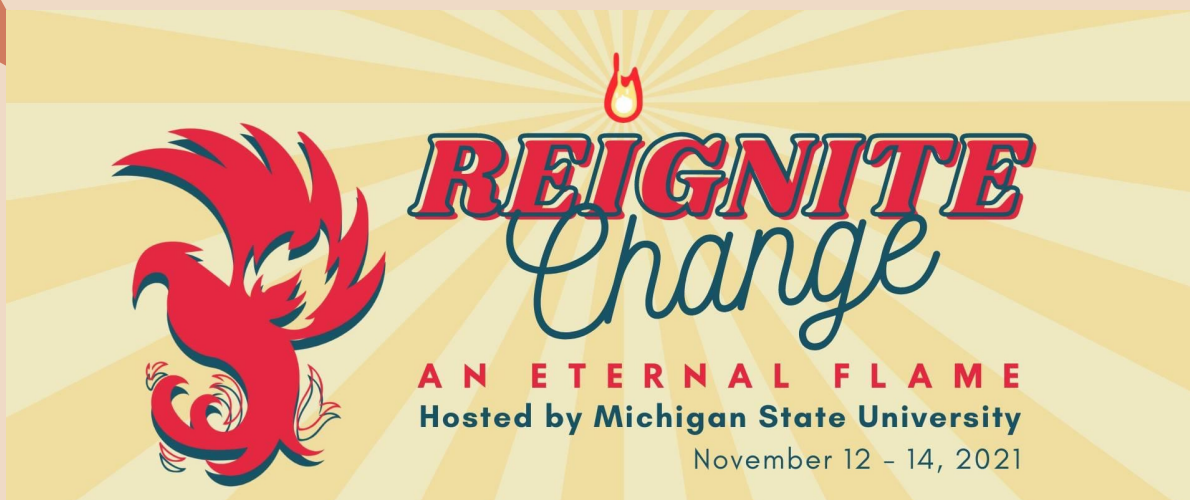
Tea Time with
