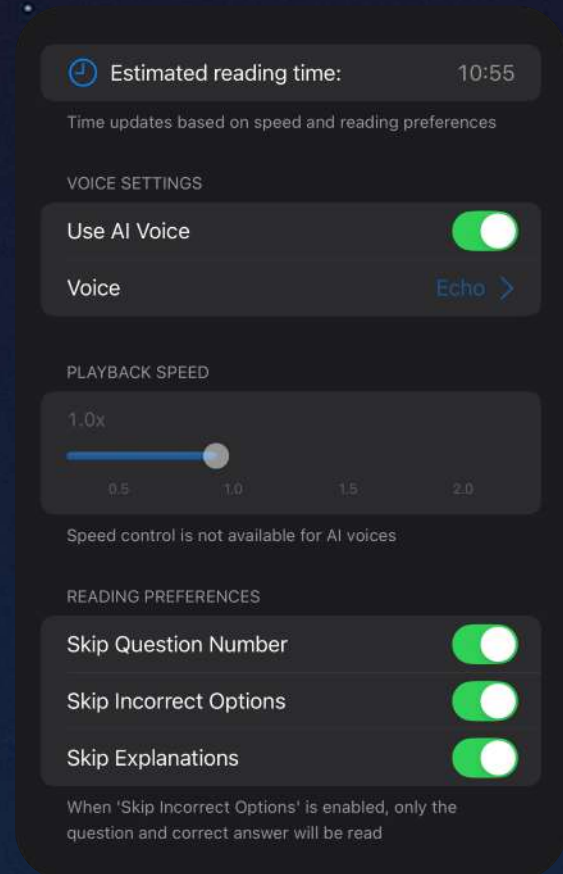

Amiodarone is the most appropriate choice for long-term rhythm control in a patient with recurrent paroxysmal atrial fibrillation due to its high efficacy and safety profile. It has been shown to be effective in maintaining sinus rhythm and reducing the risk of recurrent atrial fibrillation episodes.

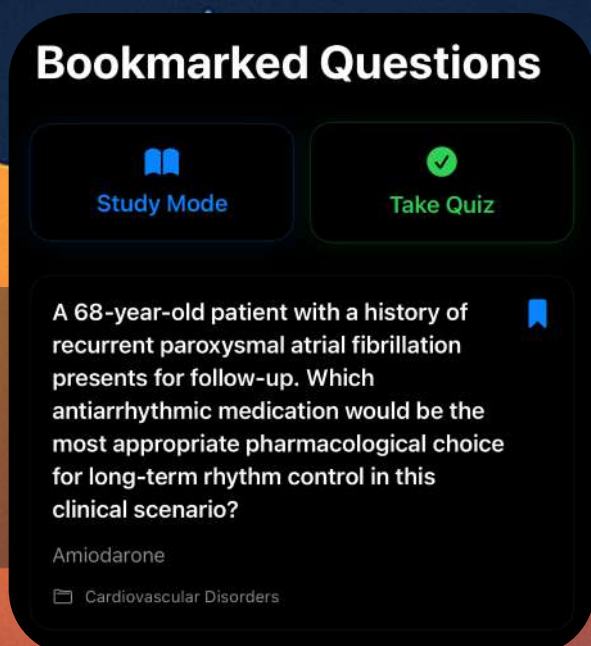
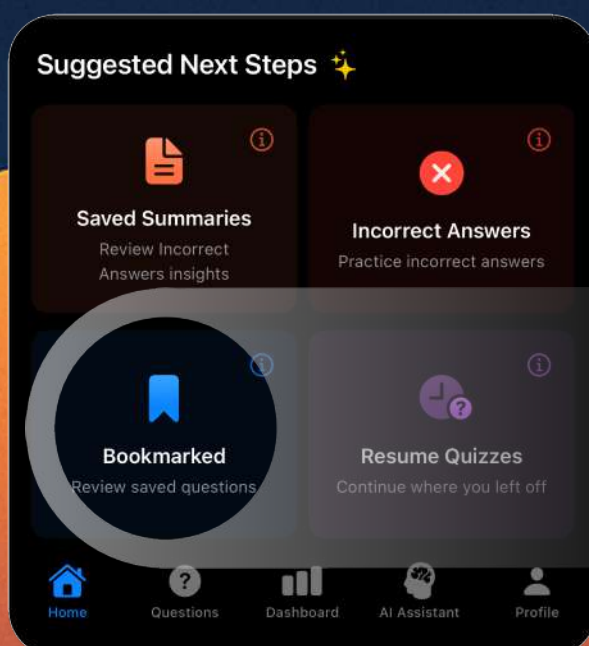

Bookmarking

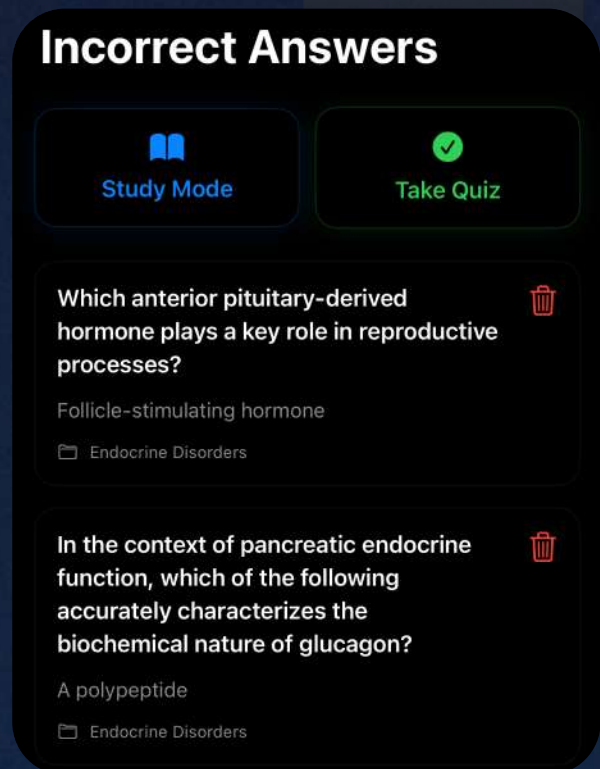
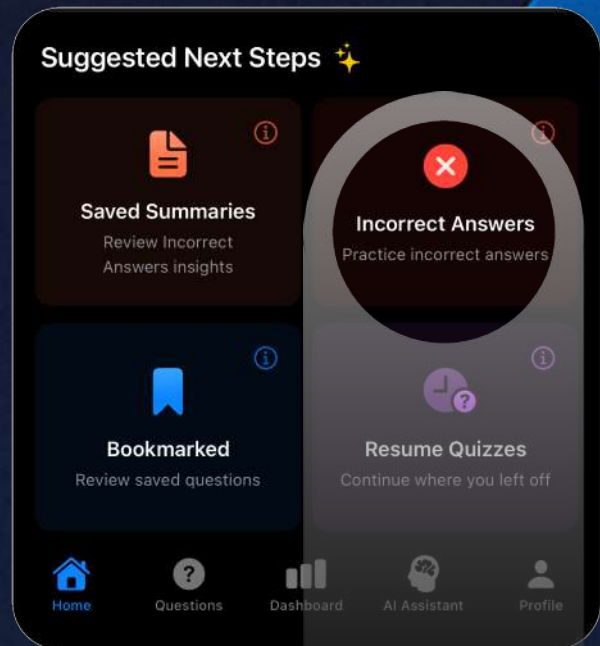
