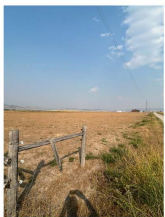

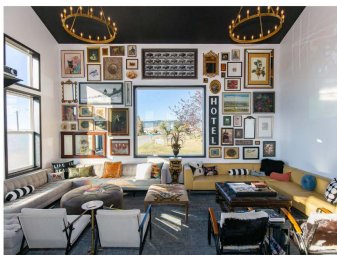
Housing

INVENTORY AND MASTER PLAN

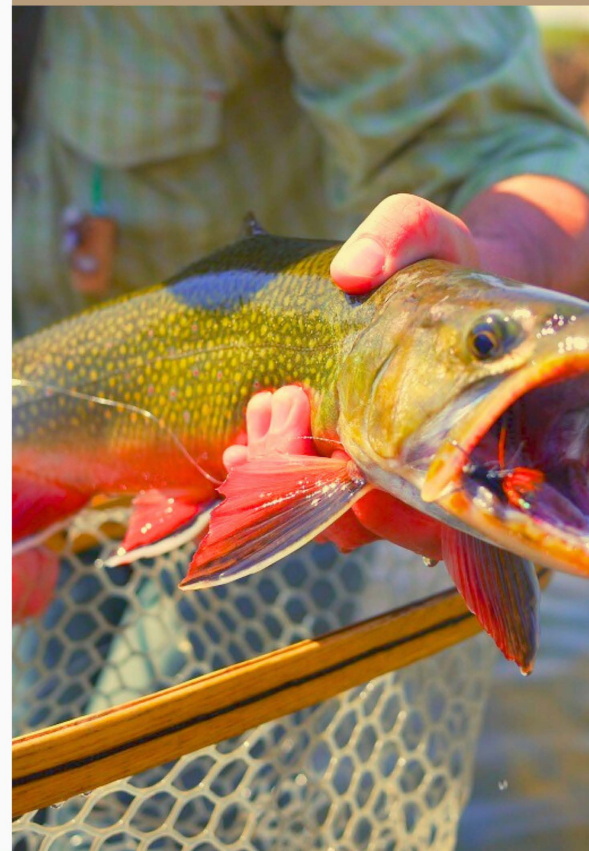
Sandfire Resources America has made progress on the Black Butte Copper Project in 2024, with updates from its drilling program at the Johnny Lee Lower Copper Zone. Highlights include copper intersections of 3.19m at 19.46% Cu and 2.79m at 11.82% Cu, contributing to the project's resource definition. Over 13,800 meters of drilling has been completed this year, focusing on upgrading and expanding the resource while gathering geotechnical and metallurgical data. The company has added additional drilling capacity and plans to complete an updated feasibility study by 2026. These activities support ongoing efforts to advance the project's development

River Conditions Tool

This tool will provide real-time data on local river flows, water quality, and other critical factors, helping residents, landowners, and outdoor enthusiasts stay informed about the conditions of our waterways.
