## Housing Master Plan Update



The Housing Master Plan is entering its final stages, with the engineered capacity for the hospital-owned property now complete. This analysis outlines how many units could feasibly be developed on the site, offering a clearer path forward for addressing our local housing shortage. The draft is under review by the Housing Advisory Committee and Hospital Board, with next steps focused on refining the concept and preparing for implementation.

## Meagher County Farmers Market-Summer Activities

This summer's Farmers Market will include a variety of engaging activities that bring natural resource education to life for all ages. Planned events include a kid-friendly weed spraying activity, a live fisheries exhibit, a wildlife presentation in partnership with Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks, and hands-on STEM activities that connect science to everyday life in Meagher County.
