# Housing Master Plan Phase I



This year marked a major milestone with the completion of Phase I of the Housing Master Plan for the Mountainview Medical Center property. Over the course of the project, nineteen public meetings and workshops were held with the Hospital Board, County Commission, City Council, Planning Board, and community members to shape the vision for a mix of housing types that could support White Sulphur Springs' growing needs. The process included an open house, design workshops, and multiple advisory committee meetings, all of which helped refine the plan into a final concept approved by the Hospital Board in August 2025. With Phase I now complete, Meagher County is preparing to apply for a CDBG Planning Grant to launch Phase II, which will include a preliminary engineering analysis and updates to the master plan to move us closer to making this project a reality
