“One bullet had pierced my helmet just over my right eye. It had sped around inside my helmet until it lost velocity. Another bullet had hit my shoe and lodged in the rubber heel. Colonel Logan E. Weston, U.S. Army (Deceased) was a veteran of three wars: World War II, Korean and Vietnam. He went from Guadalcanal and new Georgia in World War II, to volunteer with the renowned “Merrill’s Marauders” in Burma, through Korea with the “Wolfhounds” and onto the build-up of the Vietnam War. Drafted out of Bible College, his faith in God sustained him even as he was deep in enemy country. His unwavering devotion to the God he loved and the country he served earned him a larger-than-life reputation and the undying devotion from his men. A very heavily decorated war hero in U.S. military history he has received many awards and citations. His commendations included the Distinguished Service Cross, Legion of Merit, Silver Stars, Bronze Stars, Purple Hearts, and Combat Infantryman Badges, and more. Col. Weston is a member of the Inaugural class of the U.S. Army Ranger Hall of Fame at Fort Benning, GA. This is the true and inspiring
