Equipment and Connections

DEVICES: Each judge needs his/her own supported device.

CAMERAS, MICROPHONES, AND SPEAKERS: The built-in camera, microphone, and speaker for a supported device are generally adequate for tournament participation.

BROWSERS: Judges must use a supported web browser. An unsupported browser may appear to be working upon entering the tournament; however, many of the platform's features (including audio and video) will not work properly.
