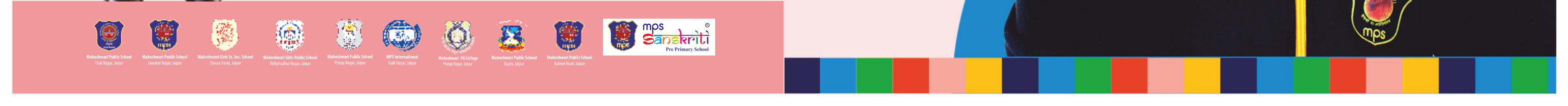

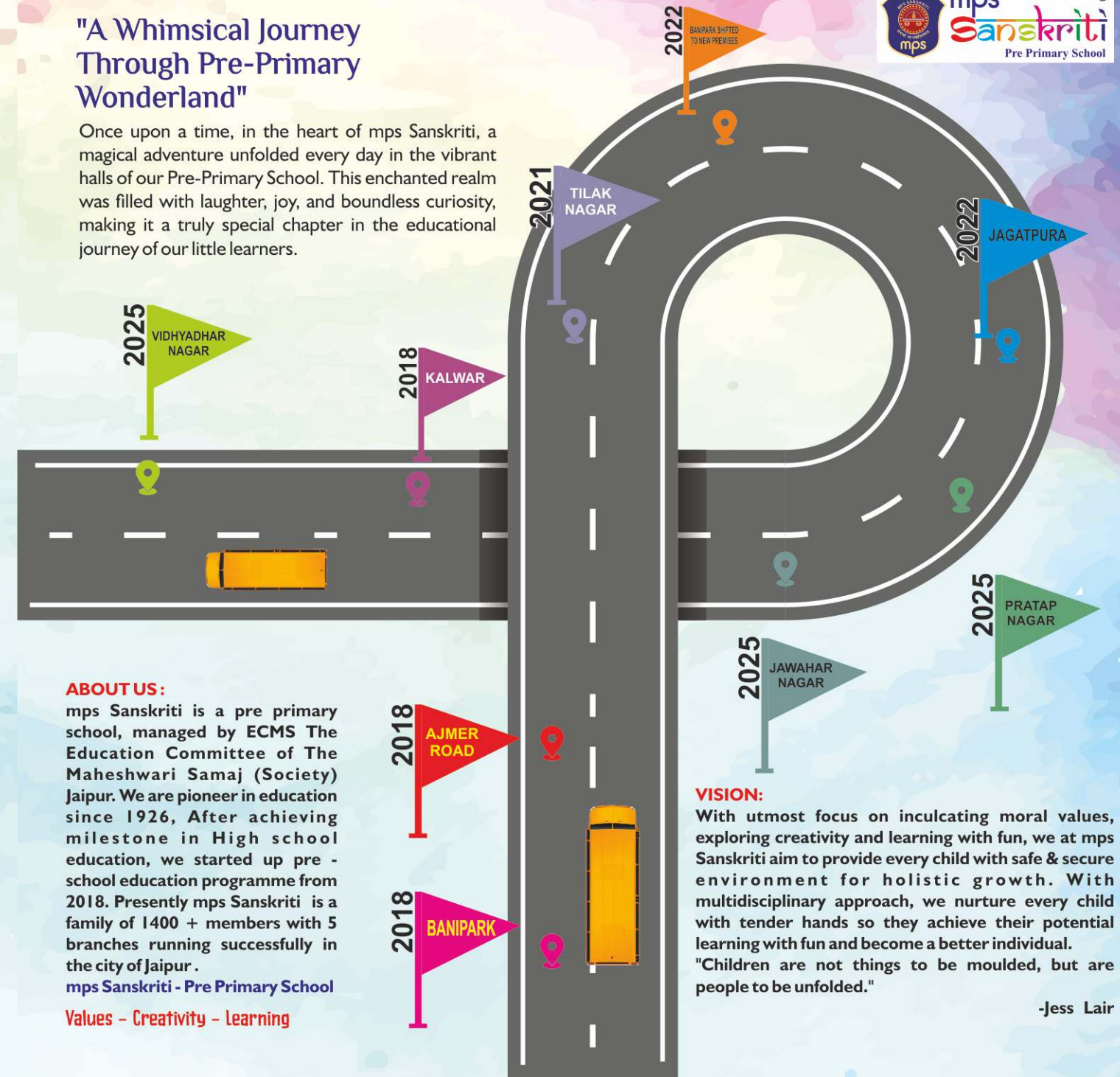

- **Variety of play equipment:** Climbing structures, slides, swings, sandpit, water features, and age-appropriate outdoor toys.
- **Natural elements:** Trees, shrubs, and gardening areas for exploration and sensory experiences.

### ESSENTIAL AMENITIES:

- Restrooms: Child-friendly lavatories and sinks with proper hygiene supplies.
- Napping area: Comfortable mats or cots for rest time.
- Sick room: A designated space for children who may need medical attention.

### SAFETY FEATURES:

- Rounded corners on furniture: To prevent injuries.
- Non-toxic materials: All surfaces and toys should be made of non-toxic materials.
- Emergency exits: Clearly marked and accessible.
- Fire safety equipment: Fire extinguishers and smoke detectors.
- Security measures: Doors with locks and proper supervision to ensure children's safety.

- Interactive whiteboards: For digital presentations and learning activities.
- Audio visual equipment: To enhance storytelling and educational experiences.
- Computer access: For teacher use and age-appropriate educational software.
