SCOPE OF WORK

Advocates recently merged with two human services organizations. As part of this merger, we acquired several programs with standalone websites. We are looking for a web development firm to assist us with the general maintenance, technical support, and upkeep of these six existing websites, in addition to specific projects related to the sites. One such project is the creation of a WordPress site for Cape Cod Family Resource Center. At this time, we are seeking proposals for ongoing website maintenance and for the creation of a WordPress website for Cape Cod Family Resource Center. Anticipated projects are outlined only to give a sense of possible future workflow.

Ongoing Website Maintenance

We are seeking ongoing website maintenance, including site health checks for security and performance, monitoring issues and bug fixing, theme and plugin updates, and occasional technical assistance and troubleshooting. Each of the six websites is currently undermanaged and out-of-date; we can make basic content changes but at times require an additional layer of support. Creation of CCFRC WordPress Website

The website for the Cape Cod Family Resource Center was built using the GoDaddy CMS. We would like the CCFRC website to be recreated using WordPress, allowing for consistency across

the six standalone program websites. The scope of this project will include creating a new website with fewer than 15 static pages and with the ability to create events. You can view the current website here: <https://capecodfamilyresourcecenter.org/>

Examples of Anticipated Website Projects

We anticipate the need for several project-based website tasks, such as consolidating the six websites onto a single hosting platform and re-theming outdated WordPress sites with special consideration given to user accessibility. Over time, we would like to explore the possibility of the same web developer managing not just our six WordPress sites, but also our main Drupal sites (www.Advocates.org, www.AutismAlliance.org, www.AutismWelcoming.org). As such, special consideration will be given to those firms who are comfortable working with both WordPress and Drupal.
