



A Look at Diabetes in Georgia



Every year an estimated **50,000 Georgia residents** are *diagnosed* with type 2 diabetes.

1 in 10 people (\sim 1.1 million) in the state are living with the condition.



Bridging the gap with virtual care

Another 2 out of 10 people who have diabetes don't know it.

Symptoms include frequent urination, excessive hunger, extreme thirst, blurred vision, fatigue and nausea.

Diabetes is expensive

2.3X

People with diabetes pay **2.3 times** more for the medical care than those without diabetes.



Diabetes can lead to complications

A 2017 Emory University study found that hospitalizations due to diabetes have climbed significantly in Georgia. Highest rates occur in rural areas, where access to care is limited.

Lack of access to care can lead to major diabetes complications.
