"Loving God with our M.I.N.D.S." is this school year's theme. In context, this command was Jesus' response to a religious leader's question "What is the greatest commandment?" Jesus answered him succinctly but comprehensively – "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your mind, and with all your strength" (Mark 12: 30)

God requires a total surrender of our whole being to Him in a loving relationship. Not by coercion, not imposing or impulsive, but total, deliberate, and in a deeply rooted love relationship. We chose to focus on the minds, because wrong thinking often leads to wrong actions or wrong behavior. If a student thinks that it is better to cheat than repeat (wrong thinking) which results in the student actually cheating in a test (wrong behavior). The effects of sin resulted in a corrupt, depraved and darkened mind. The remedy is to renew our minds with the word of God. But how many of us do really read the Bible? If we are serious about loving God with our minds, let's begin with knowing Him by reading His word. For a start, read any of the gospels and you will be amazed how God's word can heal and renew a corrupted mind, and transform your life.

ELEMENTARY CHRIST EMPHASIS

Elementary students will once again be off from regular class schedule to focus on things of God. In the gospels, we read about Mary choosing to sit at the feet of Jesus for a "chat-time" instead of going about doing some house chores. For this act of worship, Jesus commended her – "Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."

In school, there is a time for study but there is also a time for reflection on things of God. This is happening on August 8 & 9 (Gr. 1 & 2); August 13 & 14 (Gr. 3 & 4); August 15 & 16 (Gr. 5 & 6).
